UCSD CHANCELLOR TO RECEIVE INTERNATIONAL AWARD

Richard C. Atkinson, chancellor of the University of California, San Diego, is one of three educators to be honored by the World Affairs Council of San Diego at its first annual International Citizen Award dinner.

Sharing honors with Atkinson during the June 4 event at the Marriott Hotel, La Jolla, will be Thomas Day, president of San Diego State University, and Author Hughes, president of the University of San Diego. Gerald Warren, editor of the San Diego Union Tribune, will serve as master of ceremonies.

The International Citizen Award was established by the Council "to honor outstanding contributions by individuals or institutions that promote increased understanding among the peoples of the world."

Atkinson, Day and Hughes are being honored in recognition of their significant contributions to enhance global understanding through education.
