

Receipt is acknowledged of a report of the above mentioned patrol, together with your covering comments.

My observations are:

The discussion of the problems and outlook for future operations of the Arabaka Council barge is of interest.

As I understand it, it is now that a policy that government vessels may be used to assist the development of rural economies where other avenues are either lacking or unsatisfactory. Since the oil crisis has now receded, if perhaps not entirely disappeared, it is thought that increased assistance by the government to Arabaka Council may be permissible.

While the possibility of employing the barge on the Sepik when not required on the Ramu may be explored, I would mention that there is a likelihood that the government will itself acquire a barge or barges, as part of its policy to implement the 8-point Improvement Plan in the more isolated areas. If this eventuates it might be expected that such a barge could serve the Sepik. On the other hand, it is felt that a strong case can be made for CONTINUED R.I.P. assistance for operation of the Ramu barge, provided it is performing a useful service in the area.
