The excitement and pageantry of Elizabethan England will be recreated at the University of California, San Diego, from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., April 22 at UCSD's Stonehedge on the Revelle College campus. The public is invited.

The 15th annual Revelle Renaissance Faire, a student-run production, will provide a day of live entertainment, food, music, and craft vendors from the San Diego and UCSD communities.

The line-up for this year's Renaissance Faire includes the Fyne Companion Dancers, the La Jolla Renaissance Singers, Arabian Nights Gypsy Dancing, May-pole dancing, and other Renaissance dancers, singers and jugglers. This year's Faire also will feature the Society for Creative Anachronism's Artemis Festival. The SCA also will be offering country dance lessons.

A marketplace will offer products from local artisans, including Renaissance masks, costumes, weapons, and other arts and crafts. Hearty food will be available, as well as interactive games and attractions. All vendors and volunteers will be dressed in period costumes.
