

Booksale to be held by Friends of UCSD Library

April 26, 1974

Approximately 3,000 hardbound and paperback books will go on sale to the public Saturday and Sunday, May 4 and 5, on the entrance walk to the Central University Library at the University of California, San Diego.

The sale, which will be conducted by the Friends of the UCSD Library, will be held from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day.

The Friends sponsored the first such sale one year ago selling 3,000 books and netting nearly \$4,000 for the benefit of the UCSD University Library.

Most of the books will range in price from 10 to 50 cents per volume. The majority of them were collected by the Friends for the sale.

Proceeds from the event will be used by the Friends to purchase special books and materials needed for various library collections.

The Friends is made up of 1,000 community members, UCSD faculty and staff and others who support the University Library through the building of special collections and by raising funds to support its growth. Over the years, the Friends have been instrumental in helping build such special collections as those dealing with Baja California, the desert and oceanography.
