UCSD ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR OF CHEMISTRY AWARDED \$25,000

Robert E. Continetti, assistant professor of chemistry at the University of California, San Diego, has been awarded \$25,000 as a recipient of The Camille and Henry Dreyfus Foundation's New Faculty Award for 1992.

Continetti, who joined the UCSD Chemistry Department this year, received his Ph.D. from the University of California, Berkeley, and his B.S. from Johns Hopkins University.

The Camille and Henry Dreyfus Foundation is dedicated to the support of chemical research. Continetti's research involves the isolation and examination of individual chemical species that are important in combustion and atmospheric oxidation processes.
