

## UCSD-TV To Air 9th Annual Rebecca Lytle Memorial Scholarship Concert

The University of California, San Diego Television (UCSD-TV ) presents *Hymns*, a piano recital of works by Franz Liszt and George Ivanovich Gurdjieff, performed by UCSD Provost and renowned pianist Cecil Lytle. *Hymns*, the ninth annual Rebecca Lytle Memorial Scholarship Concert, will air in March beginning Friday, March 5 at 8 p.m.

The program includes late religious piano music by Liszt, *Harmonie Poetiques et Religieuses*, and Gurdjieff, *Sufi Hymns* and *Sacred Hymns*. This recital and past programs have benefited the Rebecca Lytle Memorial Scholarship Fund.

The Rebecca Lytle Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in 1995 to support and encourage a select group of first year students enrolled in UCSD's Thurgood Marshall College who are the first in their family to attend college.
