Maladina must get his sticky fingers off the constitution

PART 3 - FINAL

WHEN one looks at the whole document we call our Constitution, one will appreciate that it is a very comprehensive document that goes into minute detail to spell out what the Founders of the Constitution wanted to achieve.

The Constitution has not left anything to chance.

The fundamental principle underlying the Constitution is protection of the individual citizen.

Thus, the whole document is like a book that belongs to the ordinary people.

We cannot equate our Constitution with the book we call the Holy Bible, but it is fair to say that after the Bible, we have the Constitution.

It is a document to be revered or respected.

Unfortunately, our members of parliament do not seem to appreciate that the Constitution is a document that must not only speak for us today, but it must also speak for generations to come.

Seen in that sense, we must appreciate that the Constitution was not designed as a document of convenience to help any group of people to facilitate their agenda. What the constitution has done is to provide for the basic framework for a fair society that recognises rights and freedoms of an individual citizen and simultaneously, it provides for establishment and maintenance of a workable system of government with the necessary checks and balances.

In essence, our Constitution is a living document that embodies the wishes and aspirations of the people in the hope that in time, we the people would be able to build a strong and just society that caters for the welfare of the people. **The Constitution was never meant as a working document for our members of parliament to do a "cut-and-paste job" to suit their greed for power and glory.**

It is our view the original Section 27 of the Constitution has a two-fold effect. Firstly, Section 27 is an attempt by the Constitution to protect us, the ordinary people against excesses of power by the Executive Arm of the Government. This Section recognises that we the people are like a child still sucking its mother's breasts when compared to the powers of the mother and in this case, the government. In other words, when it comes to the crunch, the mother can abandon

us by either denying us milk, or worse still, dropping us into a public garbage can along the street and that way, allow us to die.

And in the like manner, the government can deprive us of the necessities like health, education, training and employment by diverting the funds elsewhere and generally pay no attention to our daily requirements. The end result shall be that we will be illiterate (like we are now) so that we will still live like our ancestors did, generations ago, except that in this case, we will not be living in our villages, but rather in squatter settlements like Tete, 2-Mile, Morata, Erima, and 8-Mile without water, power and all the necessities and our kids will be running around the settlement like dingoes or wild dogs.

The second effect of Section 27 is to assist our members of parliament in a way that keeps reminding them that they are in parliament not to help themselves, but to help the people so that if the OC has enough information to form the view that our member is trying to steal the K10 million he receives annually, then the Commission must issue a direction to the member under Section 27(4) that in the opinion of the Commission, the member is not acting within the spirit of the law governing leaders. In effect, this is all Section 27(4) of the Constitution does. The OC uses Section 27(4) to tell the members that in their view, he is not acting as a leader under the Constitution and other laws which demand that he must conduct himself honourably as a leader.

What the Maladina Amendment does is to water down or take away that power of the OC to give directions to our leaders to ensure compliance with Section 27 of the Constitution and other laws which require that they act like leaders and not help themselves against the interest of the people. What the Maladina Amendment is telling us is this: The OC must not stop us from stealing. If the Commission has evidence that we are stealing, then in that event, it must shut up and wait until we have completed the act of thieving (stealing), and only then, can the Commission move in and exercise its powers to get us prosecuted before the leadership tribunal for an offence and not before.

Okay, for the time being, let us accept the argument by our members that the OC should not stop them from stealing. Also assume

that the Commission sits back and watch them place that K10 million into their private bank accounts and start withdrawing from ATM Machines by use of their bank cards, and let us also assume that within 90 days, the K10 million has disappeared so the member's bank account registers a zero balance. So we ask, what happens in that event?

It is our view that two things will happen.

Firstly, the K10 million will be gone and there are no projects within the electorate which benefited from that amount of money.

And if the Commission moves in and tries to prosecute, the member may resign as a leader in which case, the Commission cannot proceed any further with prosecuting the member because he is no longer a member of parliament and thus cannot be classified as a leader, so he avoids prosecution before the Leadership Tribunal.

Secondly, what happens to that K10 million? Sorry, it has all been used up by the honourable member to benefit himself, his family and his associates. And he even used ATM machines to do the withdrawing. And what benefit did the rest of the people from his/her constituency get? A fat zero. And what happens to the member? NOTHING!

Thus, we ask: if we have enough evidence that the honourable member is about to misuse the funds, is it not reasonable for the OC to move in and stop the member from such conduct. Why should the OC sit still and wait for the member to go ahead and misuse the funds first before the Commission is allowed to enforce the law against our leaders? It does not make sense.

It is our view that ultimately, the big question boils down to this: Whose money is it anyway that the honourable member wants to spend without any sense of accountability and transparency. Is it not public money? And if it is public money, (money that does not belong to the member), then why the push to spend it freely? If, in fact, the OC has issued directions to stop that money, then in that event the member can announce to his voters that he is unable to start any projects in the electorate because the Commission, in its wisdom, is not allowing it to happen. The member can even take the OC to court to force it to abandon its directions if there is no legal basis for

the issue of such direction under Section 27(4). The member can argue that the Commission is acting in excess of its powers because there is no case for a direction to be issued under Section 27(4).

What we are saying is that Section 27(4) should be left alone because there are other ways by which the members can get around the dictates of this law. What the members can do is to allow Section 27(4) to stand as it is, but legislate on the procedures that the OC must follow in order to exercise that power of giving directions. For instance, the procedural requirement could dictate that there be a minimum evidential burden placed on the OC so that without such evidence, the OC cannot give such direction or directions. Secondly, there may also be a procedural requirement that upon receipt of a complaint on oath, the Commission must notify the member within 14 days and then complete its investigation within 30 days for example, and then notify the member of its decision, namely, whether there is any merit to proceed further in the investigation.

We agree with the general sentiments expressed by our members that if the Commission undertakes its investigation at a snail's pace, then it is quite frustrating to sit and watch the Commission move at that pace. You cannot hold up government in that fashion. This is a reasonable argument and in fact, it is true that the OC takes years to complete its investigations and in some cases, the prosecution is mounted more than 10 years after the event has transpired like it is now happening in the case of the Chief where he is now told after 10 years that he has not filed certain annual returns on his batch of free money from the Treasury. In our view, this is unacceptable.

The Commission must be given a time-frame within which to conduct its investigation and a time-frame within which to recommend prosecution. You cannot hold the members to ransom for such a length of time that seems like forever.

However, having said that, let us get back to the main question: Should we still take away or water down the power of direction under Section 27(4)? We feel that the answer must still be an unequivocal NO! We ought to leave Section 27(4) alone but build in procedural requirements to get the Commission to exercise its powers to give



directions in a speedy manner to allow the executive government to implement its projects without any unnecessary delay.

Our members have also proceeded to amend Section 28 (5) of the Constitution. What Section 28 says is that the proceedings conducted by the Leadership Tribunal are not judicial proceedings but the rules or principles of natural justice shall apply so that the leader being prosecuted is afforded a fair trial or hearing with all the legal safeguards. And the Section goes further to provide that any proceedings against the member under any other law such as the Criminal Code. The effect of this provision is that even after the member is prosecuted before the Leadership Tribunal, let us say for misuse of public funds, he can also be charged under the Criminal Code for stealing or misappropriation.

What our members have done is to change all that by saying that they will pass another law to say that once a leader has been prosecuted under the Leadership Code, the same leader cannot be taken to court for the same matter such as a charge under the Criminal Code. The proceedings before the Leadership Tribunal shall operate as a bar against any other proceedings against the leader under any other law.

In our view, this is totally wrong. The Leadership Tribunal proceedings are, in essence, proceedings which are properly called "disciplinary" proceedings for breach of the Leadership Code. They only apply to our members and others like heads of statutory bodies and constitutional office holders. It is not the general law for general application across the board. If, for instance, you are a member of any organisation like a social or a sporting club, there are rules or a code of conduct which the members of that club must observe, and where a member is in breach, certain disciplinary charges may be laid against that offending member and he may even be sacked from that club.

Let us say that the member who is sacked from his club was found guilty of striking another member within club premises. The sacking the member got was for breaching club rules and the proceedings conducted by the club to find him guilty were disciplinary proceedings and he was found guilty for committing a disciplinary offence. The fellow who was assaulted can even go ahead and charge that member for assault and have him prosecuted before a District Court and if found guilty, he can be either fined or sent to jail. And the fact that the member was sacked from his club for that offence is totally irrelevant. The general law which applies to everybody must still apply, which means the criminal law is still applicable.

What our members have now done is to say that if they are prosecuted for breach of the Leadership Code, they cannot be prosecuted before the Criminal Court for any criminal offence in respect the same subject matter which the Leadership Tribunal has considered. Thus, if each of the members steal the K10 million they get annually and then they are prosecuted by the Ombudsman Commission and found guilty by the Leadership Tribunal and then sacked from office, the same member cannot be charged under the Criminal Code for stealing. This is totally wrong and should not be allowed. Nobody who calls himself a leader would do a thing like that. This is immoral to say the least.

And the main power of the Leadership Tribunal is to recommend dismissal of the leader from office. Section 29 of the Constitution provides that where the Ombudsman Commission is satisfied that a leader is guilty of misconduct in office, the Commission may refer

the matter to the Public Prosecutor to prosecute the leader before a Leadership Tribunal and if the Tribunal finds the leader guilty, it may recommend dismissal from office. This power of dismissal has now been watered down so that upon finding a leader guilty, the Tribunal must also determine if the matter was of a very serious nature and if dismissal is really warranted and where dismissal is not warranted, in that even the Tribunal can only recommend or give the leader directions to comply with the Leadership Code.

This is an unnecessary piece of amendment. The Leadership Tribunal does not need the amendment to Section 29 to perform its functions. Upon finding a leader guilty, the Tribunal will proceed to consider if the leader should be sacked or not and the deliberations that follow will consider if the offence is of a serious nature or not, and if dismissal is warranted or not. Thus, the Section 29 amendment is totally useless.

The biggest shock must be the amendment to Section 219 of the Constitution whereby the members have proceeded to establish a Parliamentary Committee to oversee the functions of the Ombudsman Commission. The new body is called "The Ombudsman Commission Committee". The members have created a new Section 219A. The functions of the Committee are spelt out under Section 219A(2) as follows:

- (2) **The primary function of the Ombudsman Commission is, ...**
- (a) to consider and report on any report relating to an administrative complaint; and
 - (b) to monitor and review any aspect of the workings, functions, operations and administration of the Ombudsman Commission; and

- (c) to investigate on its own initiative or on complaint by a person affected and report to parliament, any conduct on the part of -
 - (i) the Ombudsman Commission or an Ombudsman Commissioner; or

- (ii) governmental body or an officer or employee of a governmental body,

where the conduct is or may be wrong; and

- (d) to refer a matter to the appropriate authorities for further investigation and prosecution, disciplinary action and to ensure compliance with the laws, as the case may be.

The above functions belong to the Ombudsman Commission. There is no rationale for our members to create a parliamentary committee to undertake functions which the Ombudsman can handle by itself. Why the duplicity? One can only assume that ultimately, the Ombudsman Commission will be abolished because its powers are now being withdrawn and the parliamentarians have now placed themselves in a position to undermine the workings of the Commission.

Our members must appreciate that in their capacity as elected members, they must protect the desires and the aspirations of the people as embodied in the Constitution.

They are trustees holding public office on behalf of the people who are the real beneficiaries. It is rather sad that our members have forgotten the oath they have sworn when they entered parliament. One thing that stands out very clearly now is that the members are all acting in concert to protect their status as parliamentarians and to empower themselves to run our lives without the nec-

essary protection against the abuses of power and governance.

With their amendment to Section 27, they have created themselves "masters of their own destiny" when it comes to spending public funds so even the Ombudsman Commission cannot stop them now, even if there is evidence that they are misusing public funds. Section 28 has been amended so that our members can avoid criminal liability if they are prosecuted under the Leadership Code. And finally, Section 219 of the Constitution has been amended so that the members have now appointed themselves to oversee the functions of the Ombudsman Commission.

In our view, this must be about the worst parliament since Independence. One thing that stands out very clearly is the greed for power and money. All these amendments are all about staying in power and spending public money. If we are unable to stop these guys violating our constitution, then we must not forget that these very people who have supported these amendments will be back on the road in the year 2012 begging us to re-elect them back to parliament.

Each one of us who will go to the polls in the 2012 must never forget what these guys have done.

We must make it our business to ensure that they are not returned to parliament. We must make it our business to throw them out in 2012.

Whether we elect better leaders in 2012 is irrelevant. Our primary goal in 2012 must be to throw these crooks, scoundrels and petty thieves out of parliament and that means the whole lot of them numbering 109 members.

Bougainville ...peace by economic means

Peace Through Economic Means

The continuing process of the Joint Supervisory Body, or JSB, which conducts consultative meetings on a regular basis to monitor and implement the observance of the progress towards peace and autonomy on Bougainville, has adopted the slogan of "Peace through Economic Means".

This is in recognition of the commonly-held understanding, that there can be no peace, and no viable autonomy, unless the Region has economic activity to provide young people with work, families with income, and the whole population with hope for a prosperous future.

The effort being put into planning and mobilising funds for high-impact projects in Bougainville, which would provide the basis for peaceful community life, was emphasised by the Deputy Prime Minister Sir Puka Temu at the JSB meeting held in early March.

The measures include restoration and strengthening of the economy as the basis for a self-reliant Bougainville, in preparation for the guaranteed referendum on independence.

"The capacity of the Autonomous Bougainville Government is being built.

"The first transfer of functions and powers requested by the ABG, powers relating to mining, oil and gas, is now in the early stages of process.

"The re-negotiation of the Bougainville Copper Agreement is also on the agenda," Sir Puka said.

The March JSB noted the progress being made on the transfer of Mining, Oil and Gas powers, including the progress being made towards the establishment of the Bougainville Administration's Department of Mining.

The JSB resolutions also noted the importance of "high impact projects", such as the Japanese Government funded bridges project.

The next JSB is scheduled for Kavieng after the election of a new Government in the Autonomous Region.

100,000 votes to decide the future course



Brukim spis....cleansing and reconciliation is ongoing

A very large number of voters are eligible to vote for members of the second parliament of the Autonomous Region of Bougainville and for the position of President.

Although voting is not compulsory, as many as 100,000 men and women could turn out to exercise their democratic right to cast a ballot, according to the newly updated common roll.

Factors such as weather and transport are expected to have an influence on the turn out when voting is held in the various constituencies.

Writs for the general election have been issued, and will be returned on June 4.

Bougainville Electoral Commissioner Reitama Taravaru said that Bougainville was well prepared to conduct the second general election in its history as an autonomous region.

Mr Taravaru said nominations closed at 4pm on April 2, and polling would be from May 7 to May 21.

The results of the election could be expected to be declared in early June.

"The new common roll updates have been completed with more than 100,000 eligible voters registered," Mr Taravaru said.

The electoral commissioner said the success story of this election process had been the breakthrough achieved by the embracing of the election by the Me'ekamui faction of the no-go area at Panguna and at Tonu in South Bougainville.

"There is not a security issue at the moment.

"Everyone is looking forward to a meaningful election and there is no threatening situation," Mr Taravaru said.

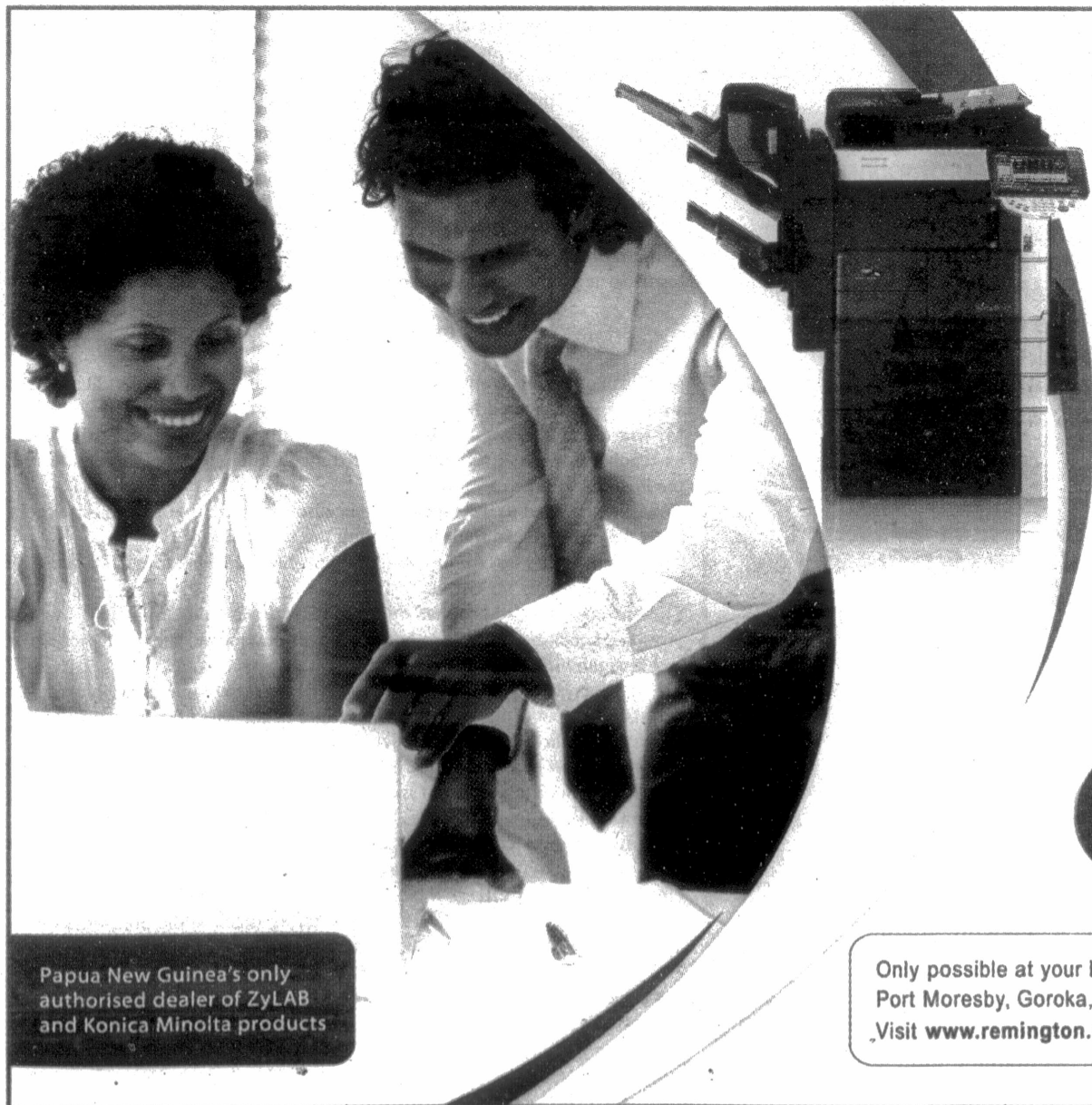
working together

Several prominent public figures, as well as acting administrator Raymond Masono and ABG ministers and members witnessed the signing, where factions were urged to work together as time was running out.

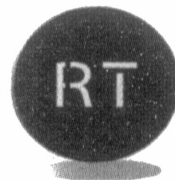
President Tanis expressed his gratitude to the original Me'ekamui faction for their cooperation with the dialogue team led by chief legal advisor Chris Siriosi.

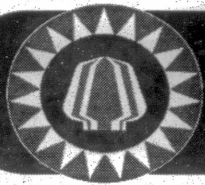

Mr Biasu who hails from Pororan island says that the Kuri Resort business is a family affair, owned by himself, his brothers and their families.

Mr Biasu and his brothers, former Burns Philp Shipping officer Albert, and ex-teacher now an ABG member, Lawrence Belleh, decided to venture into the hospitality area.

"We saw the need to do something because of the influx of business executives who made Buka their base during the restoration period.

"So we converted our family house and made extensions to what is now the Kuri Lodge," says Mr Biasu.

The business-minded brothers operated two vessels in the mid 1990's which provided much needed cargo and passenger services to the people of Buka and Bougainville.

Mr Biasu says that the economy in the ARB is slowly but surely picking up and there is a lot of money around, because of the sale of cocoa and copra.

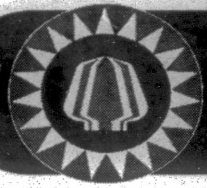
He says that the region is also picking up on cocoa export, although the destructive cocoa pod borer must be managed.

"Kuri is supporting youth and sports in the ARB, especially in soccer, boxing and softball.

"We also support churches and charity organizations and help them hold fund raising activities free of charge or on special rates."

Undoubtedly, Kuri Village Resort earns its place at the top of the hospitality businesses in the ARB and thus is contributing much to the progress of lasting peace, restoration and economic development.

For the three Pororan brothers, they are enjoying the rewards of what they started as a service oriented family venture, which has expanded into a local success story.



Necessity the mother of invention

One fruit of the Bougainville crisis, so to speak, has been the innovative use of the region's abundant crop of coconuts.

The Bougainville Coconut Oil factory, established by Mathias and Carol Horn, processes oil extracted from the humble nut to run vehicles, and to manufacture by-products including laundry and body care soap, cooking oil and cosmetics, as well as the commercial oils now seen as an alternative environmentally-friendly fuel.

The founders of Buka Metals Fabrication company first saw from the window of a plane a vision of endless rows of coconut palms all over the island, from which was born the idea of commercialising otherwise unsold copra.

This led to a successful business venture, certainly the first of its kind on Bougainville, and one of the few of its kind in PNG.

Ten years after putting their vision into reality, German immigrant Mathias and his Buka-born wife Carol are now contributing greatly to the economic re-development of Bougainville, both in the metal works and the coconut oil products, which are currently in high demand for both local consumption and overseas sale.

Joe Kevi is the operations manager of the coconut oil fuel plant, soap and oil factory at Lontis village out of Buka town.

"While on the plane, the couple saw the great number of coconut trees on the island, and thought there must be some better use for the nuts other than making copra and daily use in cooking.

"They went through many trials to work on the project and ten years

down the line, their efforts are bearing fruit," says Mr Kevi.

The company operates a mill purchased from India.

Fragrance varieties including frangipani, strawberry, citronella (more commonly known as lemon) and vanilla, as well as plain coconut, are in the range of soap and cosmetic oil varieties now sold wholesale at BMF, and retail in Buka and Arawa shops.

Buka coconut products are also sold at City Pharmacy outlets nationwide.

The cooking oil has found customers in India and Australia as well as in PNG.

"We supply a fair amount to the Australian market.

"Recently we shipped eight hundred 25 litre containers of cooking oil, and within three weeks a request came for another shipment.

"The PNG community in Cairns are our biggest customers.

"We also send shipments of cooking oil to India on request", says Mr Kevi.

He says the factory receives visitors, who request samples of oils and soap, and the feedback received is positive.

"The soap and oil have healing effects on infections and skin diseases such as fungus on the body, Mr Kevi says.

Amazingly, the factory at Lontis produces between 1500 and 1800 litres of coconut oil fuel each working day.

Shortage of diesel fuel dating from the crisis days drove the inventive spirit of the Horns, and Bougainville is believed to be the only place in PNG where coconut oil fuels vehicles.

All BMF company vehicles are running on coconut oil, and the New Zealand police in Buka and Arawa are another of BMF's biggest customers.

Mr Kevi says the coconut oil and fuel project is helping people and communities by purchasing coconuts to the value of K30,000

monthly.

As a planned expansion, bio-fuel is also being trialled at Koromira in Central Bougainville.

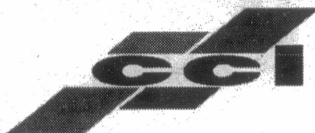
From beginnings which started with hardware, BMF has ventured successfully into other areas of commerce, including construction, road making, metal fabrications

and the unique coconut oil, soap and fuel factory.

There is little doubt that this utilization of an under-valued local resource, arising from a period of adversity, is today making a significant contribution peace, restoration and economic development.

The Cocoa Coconut Institute (formerly the Cocoa and Coconut Research Institute and the Cocoa and Coconut Extension Agency) is responsible for cocoa and coconut research and development for the nation.

Its headquarters is at Tavilo near Kerevat in East New Britain Province, where most cocoa research is carried out. The cocoa research covers breeding, agronomy, and post-harvest quality. Plant pathology, entomology and economics research, which covers both crops, is also based at Tavilo.

Coconut research, which is based at the Stewart Research Station in Madang Province, covers breeding, agronomy with alternative cash crops and downstream processing.

Extension is undertaken in all lowland provinces, with particular



emphasis on the major cocoa and copra producing areas.

CCI supplies high quality cocoa and coconut planting material, the former from Tavilo and the latter from its Omuru seed garden in Madang.

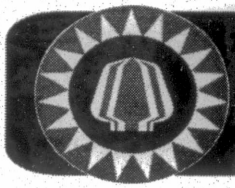

From this war zone, through the commencement of the peace process in 1997, it dawned on people from the four corners of Bougainville that in order to progress and see lasting peace, normality and economic prosperity, they would be the ones to initiate positive activities.

This was the beginning of small scale business activities in many areas, from the restoration of cocoa, copra, hospitality including guest houses, PMV trucks and buses, motorized dinghies, marine products and eventually shipping.

Among the success stories in this grass roots revival Nukumanu Holdings stands out, a Marine Products exporter and shipping company owned by the people of Tasman Islands.

Being a maritime island region, shipping is an important mode of transportation for people, agricultural market exports and businesses in the Autonomous Region of Bougainville.

On the mainland, PMV trucks and 4 wheel drives are most in demand, making daily transport runs from Buin, the southernmost tip of the Bougainville island via Siwai and Bana in the southwest through

Panguna and Arawa in Central Bougainville, thence Wakunai, Tinputz and to the final destination at Kokopau just across the Buka Passage.

The 9 or 10 hour PMV truck ride

from the southernmost part of the island passes through rough terrain of mountains, hills, valleys and more than 200 rivers and smaller water courses, which many a time put the PMV and its passengers at the mercy of nature, even risking deaths and road disasters during the peak of the rainy season.

In contrast, motorized dinghies provide an essential transport alternative in most of the coastal areas of the ARB.

For the island populations, shipping is of the utmost importance.

Nukumanu Holdings Ltd is a local company owned by the people of Tasman Islands, one of the outer island groups in the Atolls District of the ARB.

It focuses on the buying and exporting of marine products, particularly beche-de-mer and shark fin.

But more recently in 2006, five years after the company was established in 2001, Nukumanu Holdings decided to venture out into shipping with monies made from the export of its marine products, to purchase a coastal cargo vessel, the MV Nukumanu.

hardy island people

The atolls are like small drops in the ocean between the Solomon Islands and mainland Bougainville, a chain ringed by outlying small coral, home to a mere 2,000 inhabitants, having only the sea as their source of food and income earning activity. Dependence on the sea carries risks, especially that of global warming and sea level rise which is becoming a real threat, more than any other time in the history of human occupation of these tiny landfalls.

Self help is a characteristic of the hardy Islanders

According to the Managing Director of the company, Louta Atoi, Nukumanu Holdings is a service-oriented initiative of the chiefs and Tasman Island community for the people, contributing towards economic recovery, peace and normal process on Bougainville.

From humble beginnings in 1996 where the business started by buying and exporting marine products, Nukumanu Holdings Ltd has become, as of 2006, a proud owner of a cargo vessel, the MV Nukumanu.

It also is the agent for LP cooking Gas, PNG Power contractors in the ARB and Manus, exporter of

beche-de-mer when in season and owner of a service station outlet in Buka.

"Sale of marine products is the foundation of our company.

"Included under the marine products is our highest cash earner, shark fin, of which the A Grade fetches US\$250 per kilo.

"The other is beche-de-mer, with the highest grade fetching US\$80 per kilo.

"We export directly to buyers in Hong Kong and China," Mr Atoi says.

In a year, Nukumanu Holdings makes three exports of 2-3 tons overage.

local projects and services

The monies from the marine product sales goes directly to benefit the Tasman Islanders in the form of local projects and services.

"Under the direction of the chiefs, community based initiatives profit the people on the island.

"Such projects include the building of water tanks at the village and school, a food and general goods wholesale shop, sponsorship of a radio communication network, sponsorship of less fortunate island students with school fees, and transit accommodation near the airport for Tasman Islanders coming to Buka Hospital and elsewhere in PNG for medical purposes, as well as for traveling workers."

The vessel, MV Nukumanu which is a general cargo ship, makes business runs transporting retail and wholesale general merchandise and freezer goods, cocoa and copra between Rabaul and Buka, Buin and Kieta.

The vessel has a capacity to carry up to 10,000 bags of cocoa.

Slowly but surely, the service oriented vessel is providing help and opportunity throughout the region, and contributing to peace by economic means.

What of the future for Nukumanu Holdings?

"We have plans to venture into the buying of copra and cocoa, instead of just being transporters and carriers of export and market products. "We have started negotiating and we will soon be purchasing products directly.

"In the final analysis, we would like to make an improvement in the lives of our people, and attain economic independence," Mr Atoi concluded.

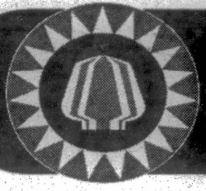

Lyna tries her hand at the hardware business

ONE positive outcome of the Bougainville crisis is the strength and vigour it has brought out in the womenfolk of the Autonomous Region. Many women are now confident to stand on the same level as men, or even to take a step further and break new ground by excelling in their work.

Some names come immediately to mind, such as that of the nominated woman member and deputy Speaker of the ABG, the vocal Francesca Semoso.

Then there is womens issues advocator Helen Hakena, President of Leitana Nehan, an NGO which for some years now has been very staunch on the plight and progress of Bougainville women.

A Catholic nun who has been working tirelessly on peace and reconciliation on the island and the winner of last year's US Woman of Courage award, Sr. Lorraine Garasu, is also on the list, together with other women in the region who have become successful in business, through their commitment, strength, honesty and perseverance.

One such person is Lyna Semoso, wife of the current regional Bougainville MP Fidelis Semoso, who is learning the ropes of the hardware business, which is generally considered to be a man's world.

Having worked with the national flag carrier Air Niugini for 16 years, Lyna decided to venture into copra buying and exporting, a game she now recognises as being "tough".

Four years on, she shifted her business focus to building construction and hardware. Formerly a family enterprise, Lyna had to take the lead in managing and administering the business when her husband Fidelis was elected to the National Parliament.

Building government houses on Sohano Island was one of the jobs undertaken by her company, which goes by the name of Bougainville Building and Supplies.

In another shift of emphasis, Lyna has put a

brake on this side of the business, and now with a scaled down workforce of ten, runs the family hardware business.

"What I do now is take customer orders and buy the required items, mostly from Lae.

"Items include the basics such as water tanks, cement, plywood, roofing iron and nails.

"I ventured into the hardware area a year ago, basically as a way to contribute to the family," says Lyna.

Lyna receives orders from schools, institutions

and private individuals, as well as Government projects.

"You have to be aggressive to succeed in the hardware business, as it is a man's world.

Two women in Buka are into the hardware industry.

Lyna is one and the other is Carol Horn of the Buka Metals Fabrication Company, who has been in the business longer than Lyna.

"But Bougainville women have done well and are able to hold on during tough times, and business women throughout Bougainville are also very vocal on local issues," Lyna says.

Lyna expresses concern over shipping services to Bougainville, which she says affect both large and small businesses throughout the region.

"Businesses in Buka have grown but there is inconsistency in shipping services.

"Freezer goods last only a week or two in the stores.

"Other basic goods such as sugar, rice, PVC pipes, hardware items and beer also run out.

"When ships finally arrive, the goods are bought straight off the wharf, because people are desperate."

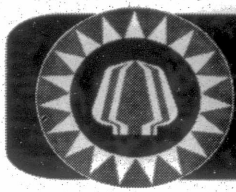
Despite these constrictions, Lyna is concentrating on making her hardware business grow, to serve the needs and demands of people who are restoring and rebuilding their lives and homes, as peace and normality gradually seep into the community.

In this way, her hardware business is contributing towards peace by economic means.

Bougainvilleans receive telecoms boost

Fourteen new Telikom VSAT terminals are being activated to serve remote population centres in the Autonomous Bougainville Region.

It is believed that this will stimulate socio-economic development and improve the efficiency of service delivery to people isolated by distance and the poor transport infrastructure of the Region.

The Autonomous Bougainville Government says improved telecommunication is a top priority, and that Telikom's VSAT system is the best choice to deliver immediate outcomes.

ABG Minister for Public Service, Communications Media and Culture, Robert Sawa traveled to Port Moresby earlier to sign a contract with Telikom's Peter Loko for the installation of the fourteen terminals and associated telephone and internet services, which is supported by funding from New Zealand.

Mr Sawa said Bougainville suffers from an unreliable communications network and the installation of the VSAT system is expected to improve communications and make a positive contribution to economic activity and social life, particularly for people in the remoter parts of the Region.

"Large numbers of our people live in rural areas, and to make a trip to town just to talk to relatives outside the Region is very expensive and time consuming.

"An efficient Telikom communication system at the people's door step is ideally the way to go, and as well as stimulating economic and social

development, we believe VSAT will help create a well informed community with knowledge of issues and developments around them," Mr Sawa said.

Mr Sawa acknowledged the New Zealand government for its contribution and Telikom PNG for its assistance in the installation of the VSAT systems.

Signing the contract agreement, Telikom acting CEO Peter Loko said placing VSAT terminals into remote locations was expensive and technically challenging, but was seen as a partnership, with Telikom staff willing to go into distant places and give of their best, to provide vital telecommunication services to the people.

"It is Telikom's vision to provide every Papua New Guinean particularly in rural areas with access to a phone by the year 2020, and it is encouraging that Members of Parliament and Government Ministers share the vision."

Mr. Sawa foreshadowed that the ABG will continue to invoke a close working partnership with Telikom. Telikom VSAT provides a small but powerful satellite terminal, powered by solar energy in the many places in PNG not in reach of rural electrification, making possible direct communication to the Telikom hub at Boroko.

Hanging off the smaller terminal can be six telephone lines, including public phones, district office and health centre phones, and perhaps an internet access link for school children.

VSAT a potential life saver

Telikom VSAT satellite communication systems are proving to be not only a convenient means of maintaining social and commercial contact, for people in outlying communities. VSAT is also proving to be a potential life-saver, and a means of security.

The serious threat of tidal inundation, believed to be caused by rising sea levels and climate change, has recently caused fear of drowning and loss of life in the Carteret and Mortlock island groups, north east of Bougainville.

The island communities were amongst the hardest hit by recent king tides, which sent sea water washing into villages, and flooded gardens with salt.

a sense of panic

The threat of food and fresh water shortages was made worse by a sense of panic among the residents of the low-lying islands and atolls, that inevitably the sea surrounding their traditional homes is rising, and that a storm surge at some time in the future may well carry them away.

As many as 2500 men, women and children are affected by this constantly worrying threat.

Autonomous Bougainville Government Member for Atolls, Paius Taaeu said the recent king tides proved to be a frightening situation for the islanders, as such an occurrence had never been experienced before on such a threatening scale.

"I am very appreciative of the Telikom VSAT system in Mortlock as I received a phone call from the islands notifying me of the fears of the people following the king tide.

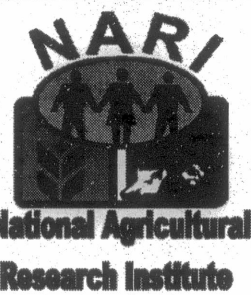
"I was then able to request the administrator to deploy timely assistance to the people."

Telikom PNG installed the VSAT system on Mortlock in October last year under its community service obligation program.

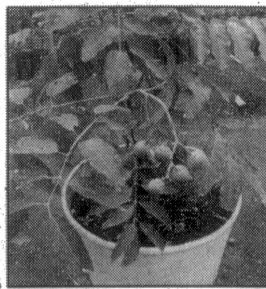

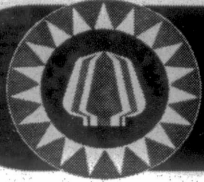

New Dawn FM- Strengthening peace through its broadcasts

WHERE there is a will, there is a way surely rings true for former National Broadcasting Commission's Radio Bougainville broadcaster Aloysius Laukai.

TV, radio and newspaper industries are usually dominated by big business interests due to the high costs involved in production.

New Dawn FM radio is a big challenge, for strong willed persons in the likes of Aloysius.

And he is doing it with enthusiasm, commitment and dedication.

"I saw the need for independent media so I decided to give it a try. I brought together a group of ex-broadcasters from Bougainville and came up with the business plan. We then asked around for funding support and UNESCO together with the German government came good for us," says Aloysius.

The German government assisted with the provision of equipment.

Aloysius says many who initially joined them gave up, especially when no pay was forthcoming.

"Many who helped with the initiative left when the going got tough, but I continued with my family and a few friends," says Aloysius, who recently received an international award from the University of Queensland's School of Journalism and Communication, just one year

after first going on air.

The award is for outstanding contribution to the theory and practice of communication and social change, consisting of a commemorative plaque and a cash prize of A\$2,500. Last year, New Dawn FM grabbed the top prize ahead of 19 entries from Bangladesh, Burundi, Canada, Congo, New Zealand, Nigeria, Philippines, Fiji, India, Rwanda, Sierra Leone, Uganda and the USA as well as Papua New Guinea.

New Dawn FM was established with the assistance of a group of Australians who had worked in broadcasting in PNG, including Keith Jackson, Phil Charley and Martin Hadlow.

Aloysius says that the station focuses on local Bougainville content in news, music, developmental areas, autonomy and thereafter.

It broadcasts 7 days a week commencing at 5am to 12 midnight, on 95.3 FM.

The radio station now has a staff of 13 young and enthusiastic broadcasters and staffers, headed by Aloysius as the Director.

Currently, it transmits to Buka and north Bougainville as far as Wakunai but it is hoped that transmission will be extended to Arawa and Buin.

New Dawn FM is now giving an alternative medium to the people of Bougainville as well as support-



ing peace, reconciliation, weapons disposal, services and development, autonomy and the referendum.

As New Dawn FM expands to bigger and better things, including shifting to a new studio in Buka, it is also moving on in the media world in terms of training, conference attendances and taking on challenging issues in the Autonomous Region.

Recently, Mr Laukai returned from a

week-long radio broadcasters workshop conference in India where he joined more than 300 world association of community based broadcasters who delved into issues pertaining to their area and ways they can help communities gain education on global issues such as health, education, climate change and food security, which impacts them, their families, communities and countries.

Mr Laukai says that this year, the station will work with communities to bring home educational messages and awareness on health, focussing on diabetes.

He also says that he is looking at introducing a school of air, a program project from the Commonwealth of Learning.

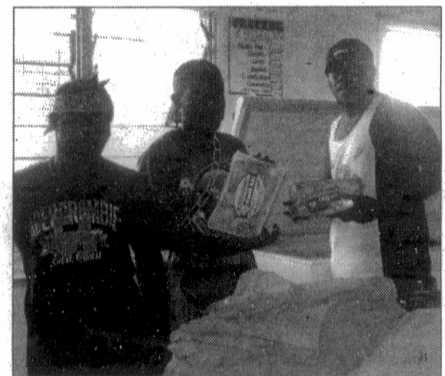

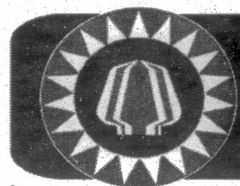

Jomik Enterprises - a family affair

The enormous opportunities for trade and commerce that are available within the Autonomous Bougainville Region could not be better exemplified by the growth and success of a family-owned business.

Although the family has known tragedy and loss, it could almost be said that the crisis was in some ways good for Michael and Josephine Huuma.

Some fourteen years ago, the husband and wife team were running a humble canteen in the Siwai region of South West Bougainville, selling basic foodstuffs and household items, while they strove to educate their children.

A move to Buka, something that was not uncommon in the strife-torn days, saw the small business, Jomik Trading translated from the familiar environment of the Siwai to the unknown territory of the northern island.

From such humble and potentially threatening beginnings, Jomik Trading has expanded into a flourishing enterprise, venturing into retail, wholesale, warehousing, general merchandising of rice, tinned fish, meat, soft drinks, alcoholic beverages, and clothing.

Jomik is also into freezer goods, plant hire, and involved in roadwork construction and maintenance on the major trunk road from South Bougainville through Central and on to Buka.

It is the major agent and distributor in the Autonomous Region for Trukai rice, Hugo Canning, SP Brewery and Coca Cola.

At the height of its success, the family experienced the untimely death of husband and father Michael Huuma.

Jomik remains a family business, now owned and operated by Josephine Huuma and her children, from their base in Buka. Their fully stocked wholesale warehouse and retail shops are in Buka, Kokopau and

Arawa.

Managing Director Josephine says the rapid expansion of the business was unexpected, and came almost as a surprise.

"I attribute our success to our faith in God's goodness, and to good sound family management and support."

"That support has come in the form of hard work by my late husband and myself, and by my children."

While her eldest son looks after the accounts, second born son Rodney manages the Kokopau operations.

Another son manages the plant hire business, while daughter Irene, a graduate in business and accounting from Lae Technical College, is the office manager and administrator.

The family members are the only shareholders.

Josephine Huuma says they have further expansion plans, which may see Jomik operations moving south

again, depending on shipping services.

Business expansion is presently hampered by the shortage of suitable land for commercial activities, and the lack of government services particularly on the mainland.

Gender workshop empowers women

A UNIFEM sponsored week-long gender and election workshop held in Buka recently aimed to give empowerment and understanding to women on election issues, and the need for both men and women to be involved in choosing the new government.

About 50 women leaders from the four regions, north, central and south Bougainville and the Atolls, as well as Buka-based reporters and political party representatives sat through the workshop at the Kuri Village resort in March. With the second Autonomous Bougainville Government elections now under way, UNIFEM, an agency of the United Nations, sponsored the workshop in the belief that more women needed to stand for parliamentary positions.

Political party members were invited so that they could be reminded of the need to have both men and women standing in the elections, while the involvement of the media was to encourage balance in reporting on gender issues.

It was understood that some of the women who attended were intending candidates in the region's elections, and the workshop aimed to increase their understanding of the opportunities, as well as the roles and responsibilities as elected members, should they succeed.

When nominations closed, there were eighteen candidates standing in seats reserved for women, and several others contesting open

seats. Bougainville Electoral Commissioner Reitama Taravaru said more women should be engaged in election work as he believed that they make good administrators, displaying hard work and impartiality.

He said this had been proven in past elections when women were engaged in electoral work on Bougainville.

As a further comment on the election process, Mr Taravaru explained the Recall provision in the Bougainville Electoral Law, enacted to provide extra powers to continue monitoring members of parliament and to recall any of them seen to be corrupted or to have broken the laws of the land.

This recall provision applies after a grace period of 18 months following elections.

Mr Taravaru said that to date, the provision had not been used but remained available.

He also emphasised that to ensure participation in the voting process, both the voters and candidates must check their names on the common roll before the final version is printed. The new Bougainville Common Roll has been updated with the involvement of the Council of Chiefs, as they are the authority in their respective areas.

He said it was easier to update the common roll with the help of people who know their local area, whereas in the past, only government officers were involved in updating the rolls, which as a result were not 100 percent accurate.

Establishing and operating a small business also calls for knowledge of permits, licences and other documentation, and travel in and out of the Region includes tourism.

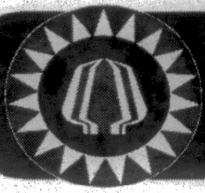

New recruits told to uphold the law



Every woman on Bougainville will have access to a female police officer, providing advice, support and protection within her home community, as Bougainville Police numbers come up to full strength.

Although the police women now being trained and inducted into the force receive a short, concentrated period of instruction, they have full police powers to enforce law and order, and to arrest and charge law breakers.

Twenty percent of the full strength Bougainville Police will be female officers, their team leader Murray Lewis said.

He was speaking as the latest batch of recruits received their final period of instruction, before

being posted as Community Auxiliary Police.

"It is very important that women in the community can have a female police officer to turn to for support, particularly in matters regarding home and family.

"But these young police officers also have all the powers and responsibilities of general duties police.

"They will be respected and have authority within their own communities because it is from those communities that they have been nominated," Mr Lewis said.

The New Zealand aid program to Bougainville is facilitating the community policing project.

The rationale behind recruiting and retaining women in the community police auxiliary is that it will not only make female officers more accessible in the community, but will also raise the profile of women in general, provide women with a role to enforce law and order alongside male auxiliary police, and assist in providing a better response to crime and other events in the community.

To date the number of women in

the CAP has risen from five percent to almost the twenty percent target, out of a total establishment of 350 auxiliaries.

Not all would-be auxiliaries make a success of their new careers as law enforcers.

Some find the work too demanding, or for other reasons fail to perform their duties to the satisfaction of their team leaders, and several have been terminated.

This unfortunate outcome has the positive benefit of making room for new recruits, and overall the scheme has proved to be an outstanding success

The recent emphasis has been to deploy the new police men and women into areas of Central and South Bougainville, where there is a demand for the services of women police in the communities.

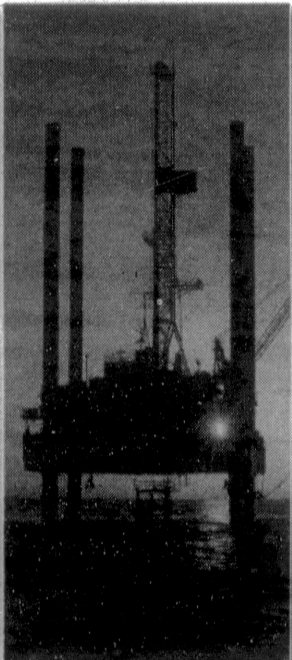
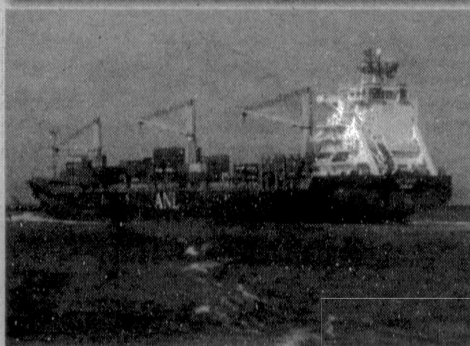
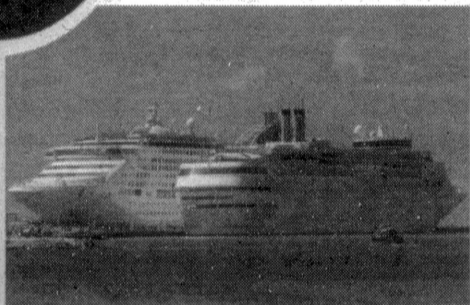
Women CAPs have also been recruited, trained and placed in the Atolls communities.

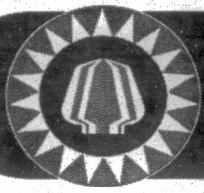

WITH its retail mini-mart in Buka town and a wholesale at Kokopau across the popular Buka Passage, JOCIA Enterprises Ltd, a modest but growing trade store business is contributing to the economic development, peace building and rehabilitation in the Autonomous Region of Bougainville (ARB).

The owners of Jocia Enterprises are retired public servants, Joe Mokuma, who was the former Bougainville Tourism officer, and wife Cecilia, who was a primary school teacher of many years.

Of their four offspring, comprising three sons and a daughter, the elder son is now helping to run the business while the others are still at school.

The name Jocia is a combination of the first two letters of the husband's name (Jo) and three of the wife's name, Cia.

Jocia was started off as something to fall back on for the family in 1998, in the event that Mr and Mrs Mokuma quit work.

Today, shop assistants at Jocia's two

outlets are kept busy by a never ending stream of customers, drawn by the variety of goods, and affordable prices, not always available in booming Buka town. Jocia offers general merchandise ranging from basic food items including rice, tinned meat and fish, flour, sugar, milk, a variety of biscuits, noodles, freezer goods, soft drinks, kitchen, cooking and eating utensils, buckets, laundry baskets, clothing for adults, children and babies and other items suited to the public needs.

In a nutshell, the outlets are vibrant, flourishing, with a range of goods that are much sought after by customers who come from all over the ARB.

The mini-mart has an edge to most other outlets as it is situated at a convenient hub of business activity in the small township of Buka, while the same could be said of the wholesale outlet at Kokopau, which is located within easy reach of a never ending flow of customers who arrive from the four corners of mainland Bougainville, six days a week.

Public demand gave rise to the opening of the mini-mart in Buka town in May 2009, as an offshoot of the operation at Kokopau.

putting back into the community

Jocia Enterprises is "a shop with a difference", giving opportunity for young Bougainvilleans to do something to enhance their lives and to undergo studies while working.

"In all, we employ 27 young people in our two outlets, but we are hoping to extend to Buin, depending on our assessment of the security situation in South

Bougainville," says the ever cheerful and energetic Cecilia who is the main driving force behind this small but vibrant business.

"We take in young boys and girls from all over the ARB who are looking for job opportunities and are committed and happy to work.

"Most are Grade 8 and 10 school leavers, however, we have helped some of them, six to be precise, to continue their schooling at the Kubu study extension centre.

"I also say that Jocia is a shop which aims to make a difference since some of our workers are given the chance to attend classes while still working for us.

"Two have now gone to teachers colleges at Kabaleo and Gaulim in East New Britain," says Cecilia.

A soon to be added addition to the business will be a Take Away outlet, for which equipment has already arrived.

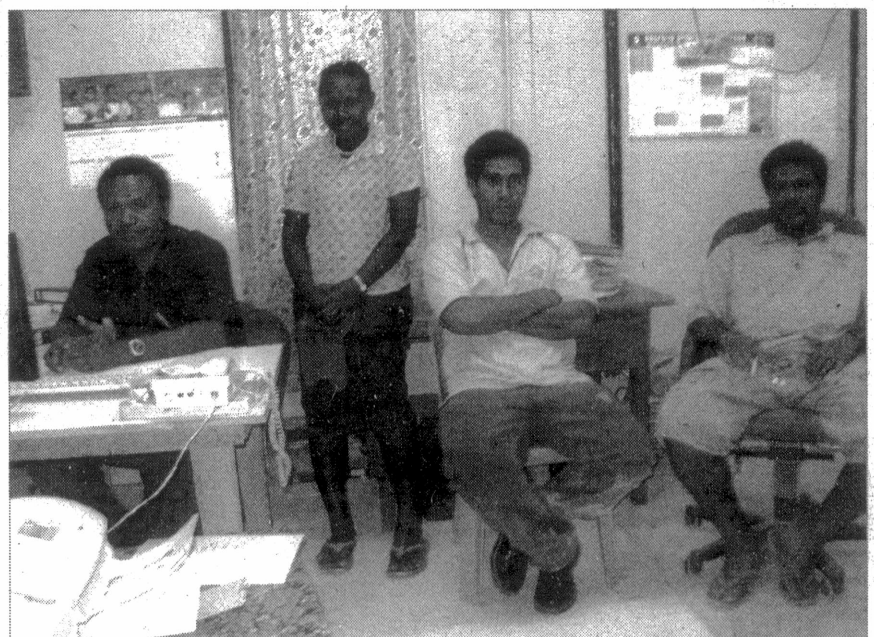

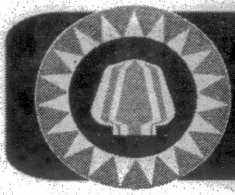

CPB not all bad news

There was good news about cocoa from Bougainville last year, that cocoa production had increased so that the Autonomous Region produced more cocoa than any province in PNG, the first time it had held this position since 1989.

There was also some bad news, that the Cocoa Pod Borer (CPB) had been found on mainland Bougainville.

As soon as the first report of the suspected pod borer outbreak was received, CCI sent two senior officers to confirm the report and find out how far the pest had spread.

The first confirmed outbreak was at Boira village near Arawa, and the pod borer was also found on Inus plantation, Numa Numa plantation and at Kunua Keriaka, also in western Bougainville.

Speculation that it was also in south west Bougainville could not be confirmed.

After discussion between CCI and ARB officials, it was decided not to try to eradicate the cocoa pod borer. This was because eradication attempts had not been successful anywhere else in Papua New Guinea, or other countries.

loss of income

Eradication involves removing and burying all the pods on all cocoa trees in the eradication zone, which means that cocoa farmers have no income from their cocoa for up to one year. Instead, it was agreed to focus on managing cocoa blocks to minimise the pest.

This means creating conditions in cocoa blocks that make it hard for the CPB moth to live and lay eggs.

This is done by following what are called the "Five Golden Rules" of cocoa pod borer control.

The Five Golden Rules are:

1. Clear weeds and reduce shade
2. Prune cocoa trees (control height to 3 - 4 metres and reduce canopy)
3. Do Frequent, Complete Harvesting (Every Pod, Every tree, Every Week)
4. Bury infested pods and pod husks after every harvest
5. Target spray pods (on pod surface and underside of branches).

Farmers who follow these rules will see fewer CPB infested pods in their blocks.

The frequent harvesting will also reduce the number of pods affected by black pod. Regular pruning and weed control will help to increase the number of pods that the cocoa trees produce, possibly to higher levels than before the arrival of CPB.

Except for spraying, the first four rules can be followed using tools that

every farmer already has.

The more farmers in an area who follow these rules, the better will be the control of CPB in all their cocoa blocks.

A management strategy for CPB in Bougainville was developed by CCI officers and their colleagues in different departments of the ARB Government.

The plan was accepted at an inception meeting, attended by the national Minister for Agriculture and Livestock John Hickey, and all stakeholders in the Bougainville cocoa industry.

CPB can have a positive side, by giving farmers a big reason to increase inputs to their cocoa blocks, which will increase production over time.

CCI has been doing other work in Bougainville to show farmers ways to increase their cocoa production.

four options

The technology package, called Integrated Pest and Disease Management, or IPDM, has four options that farmers can choose from. Option 1, farmers continue to manage their cocoa

in the same way.

Option 2, farmers prune their cocoa and shade trees regularly, do regular manual weeding, use simple manual methods to control pests and disease, and harvest all ripe pods every week.

Option 3 has all the practices of option 2, plus applying fertiliser

Option 4 adds chemical weed, pest and disease control.

Groups of twelve farmers in three locations, namely Buka, Arawa, and Tinputz,

are using each of the four options in their cocoa blocks, so that

other farmers in the area can see the results for themselves and choose which one to use.

Since the IPDM project started, farmers have stopped using Option 1 when they have seen the increased production from the other options.

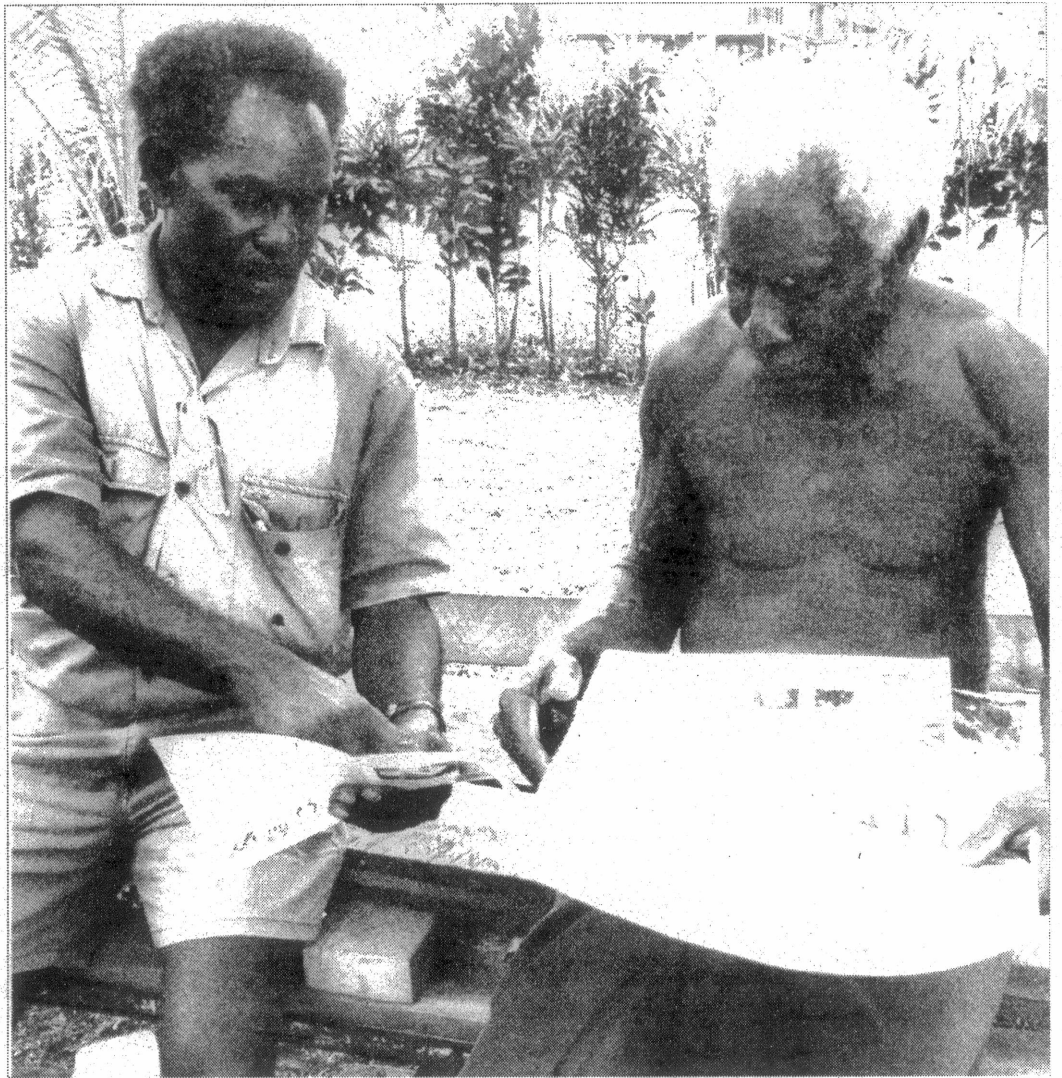
Reports from Bougainville indicate that many farmers have started using the IPDM package after seeing the results.

The likely spread of the cocoa pod borer through Bougainville is a real challenge for the continued increase in cocoa production.

The Five Golden Rules and IPDM options 2, 3, or 4 give farmers ways to

greatly reduce losses of cocoa crop due to CPB and the other pests and diseases that can attack cocoa.

When they do this, the farmers can expect higher cocoa production and higher incomes, and improved livelihoods.

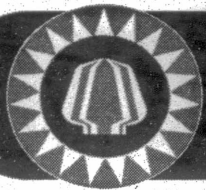

A lone man's effort contributes to education and development in the ARB

BOUGAINVILLE is slowly picking up the pieces in providing young people with an education, much disrupted when the war and discord waged on the island for 10 years.

Prior to the conflict, Bougainville had an excellent academic record in its education institutions, but the years of disturbance, displacement and closure of both staff and students took the region 20 years backwards, with many youngsters missing out on schooling altogether.

Today, as normality slowly trickles into many areas of mainland Bougainville previously bound up in darkness and fear, schools and health centres are opening up again, to cater for a lost generation.

It will no doubt take years of hard work, commitment and dedication bring education opportunities back to previous levels.

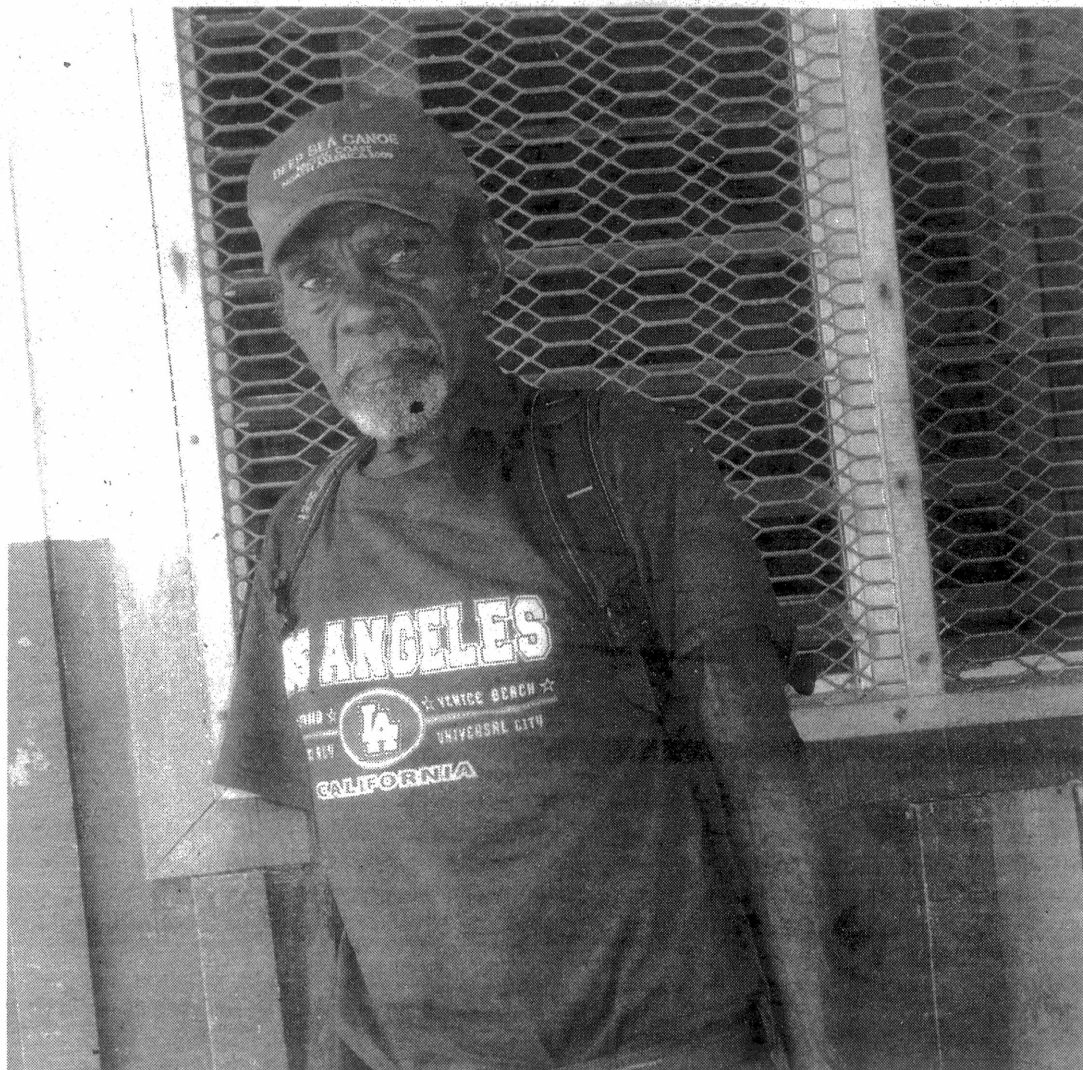
Setting a fine example are the efforts of one man, providing education without much assistance from the government, and moving to offer the young generation of Bougainvilleans the chance they missed out on during the years of conflict.

Luke Deukari, a man of action who practices self-reliance at its best, is no stranger to many on Bougainville, as the founder of the Inong Private Elementary and Lower Primary school in Siwai, southwest Bougainville.

He was a one-time Minister for Works and Justice and Rino Constituency member, Siwai in south Bougainville with the North Solomons Provincial Government from 1979-1987.

This strong-willed and brave father and grand-dad, started off with Viles Tok Ples (Village Tokples School) in 1990, just when the Bougainville conflict was at its height.

Mr Deukari used his own money to kick start the school and even today, 20 years on, he is still using his money and that of his own

children to expand the school and take it up to another level, lower primary catering for grades 4, 5 and 6.

With the normal academic subjects taught, his school prioritises physical and spiritual studies, sometimes described as integral human development, at the same time as preserving indigenous values and traditions.

What is the thinking behind starting such a school, an expensive exercise where first and foremost one must have the finance, resources and infrastructure to ensure continuity?

"I saw the need to assist my people by bringing education services right to their doorstep, but with nil

help from the government," says Mr Deukari.

At the elementary level, a K20 per student school fee is charged per year while for the lower primary, it is K40 per year.

His perseverance through the years has paid off in no small way as the Elementary Prep 1-2 now get a K400 school subsidy from the education authorities of the Autonomous Bougainville Government.

Nine teachers who have attended in-service courses with other elementary school teachers on Bougainville are employed at the elementary level of the school on Mr Deukari's payroll, with an additional seven teachers now

taking the lower primary grades of 3,4, 5 & 6.

This year, the number of students, ranging from 6 year olds to young adolescents around 12 years of age, has increased to 107 students.

Mr Deukari says after early schooling, his students go to Government schools nearest to Inong, such as Tonu, Monoitu and Sinninai Primary Schools.

He is proud to say that last year's Grade 7 at Tonu Primary was topped by an ex-student from Inong.

A permanent double classroom, built at a cost of K73,000 was completed last year while a new double building is also under con-

struction which will house 4 classrooms and an assembly.

Mr Deukari says that despite his request for education officers to visit his school, no one has yet made it.

But this does not deter him from what he is determined to do.

When he started the school in 1990, he came to Port Moresby and purchased some text books, the same as used by the national education curriculum in PNG.

The students are taught in Viles Tokples or the local vernacular, and in English.

Traditional customs, counting in Tokples, handcrafts, and the preservation of culture are all included.

Mr Deukari's vision is to take the school up to 6 levels, but he wants the Education Department to inspect and assess the school.

"People expect the government to bring in development, but people themselves must take the initiative and do things for themselves.

"It is sad to say that those of us who take the initiative to do things on our own do not always get recognition from the government," says Mr Deukari.

Mr Deukari received an award in 1985 from the Queen's Birthday Honours list for distinguished services to government.

Another award came in 1992, as the Peace chairman and in 1997, he received the peace award medal for his role in overseeing the Tonu care-centre, with more than 3,000 people from the Motuna area accommodated there for some years until the situation allowed them to return to their villages around 1998.

As the days, months and years go by, Luke Deukari gets a feeling of satisfaction that he is doing something to contribute towards peace, development and the education of the future generation of Bougainvilleans, who might otherwise be missing out on an essential right, had it not been for his unique private school in a rural Bougainville setting.



Vale Douglas Oliver

A respected friend of many Bougainvilleans has passed away. Douglas Oliver, an American author and anthropologist, died peacefully in his sleep late last year, in Honolulu at the age of 96.

He was widely regarded as the dean of Pacific anthropologists, and spent time living and working among Nasioi-speaking people on Bougainville.

As a young graduate, he took up an appointment as a research associate at Harvard University, until in 1938 he went to what is now Papua New Guinea.

He published "A Solomon Island Society" based on his work among the Siuai people of South Bougainville, in 1955.

It introduced to an anthropological audience the concept of "Big Man" leadership in Melanesia, an idea which continues to shape discussion for specialists in the area.

Douglas Oliver's expertise in Pacific Island studies gave him a role in the Second World War and thereafter.

After the war he led a team assessing economic policy in Micronesia. When the large mineral deposit was discovered at Panguna, Oliver

was hired in 1968 as a consultant to development, because of his previous extensive field work on Bougainville.

Among 14 books published during his lifetime, Professor Oliver wrote "Bougainville a Personal History" and "Black Islanders: a Personal Perspective of Bougainville 1937-1991".

More recently, his research and field work over fifty years gave Douglas Oliver a perspective from which to pose several important questions regarding "the Pacific's most damaging independence

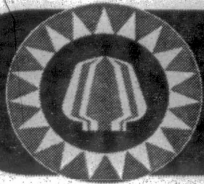
movement".

His approach was to examine current events against the background of the people's diverse cultures and history, past enmity and mutual dependence.

He also asked whether overpopulation might be a graver problem long term than division of the fruits of mineral development.

Many Bougainvilleans will remember Douglas Oliver as friend and wantok.

At his request, his ashes were taken by canoe to be scattered off Waikiki Beach.

K6 million invested in the concept of conflict free mining

The investment in capacity building made by the World Bank has come at a very good time, if reports are confirmed that the drawdown of mining powers to the Autonomous Bougainville Government has been approved by the Somare Government.

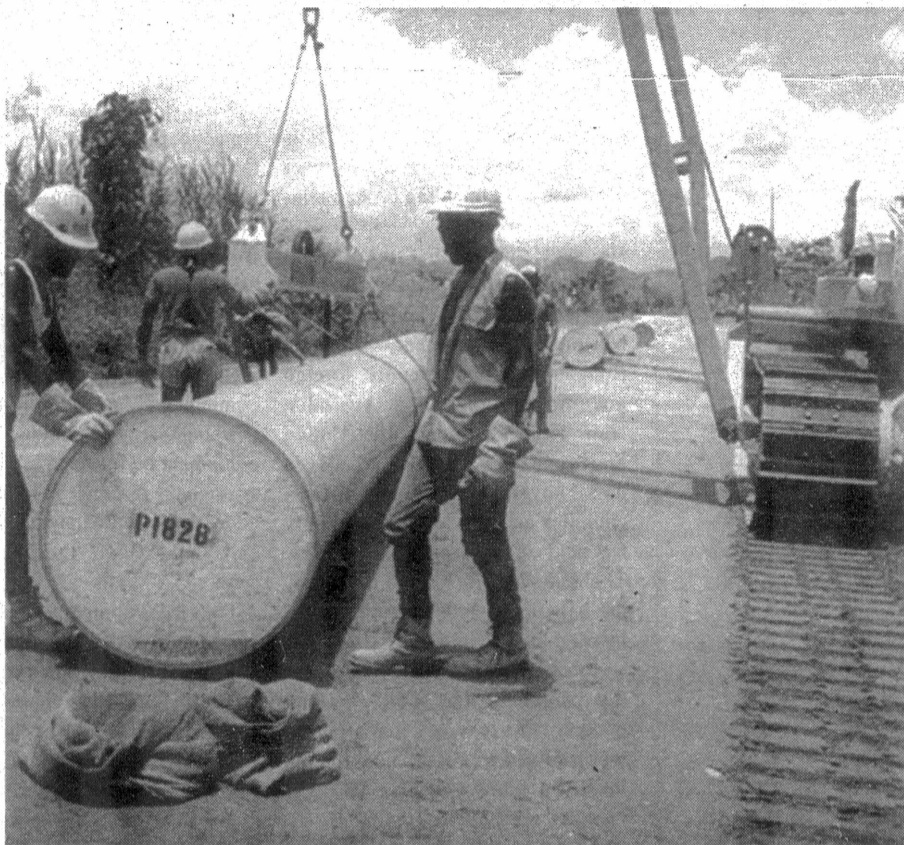
This capacity building in the ranks of the ABG administration has been held out as a requirement leading to the drawdown of mining powers.

It now appears that the National Government has agreed, following the last meeting of the JSB in Port Moresby in March, that issues critical to economic development for the people of Bougainville, including the drawdown of powers and the review of the Bougainville Copper Agreement, have been approved.

If this is confirmed in the coming weeks, it will facilitate planning for large scale economic development, at the same time as the Autonomous Government continues its program to increase capacity to handle large projects.

Two mining department officers, specialists in environmental science and communications respectively, recently experienced attachments with the Mineral Resources Authority and the national Department of Mining.

As the training increases the technical skill levels, transitional arrangements are likely to be in place to facilitate a possible return to mineral exploration and mining on Bougainville, reports from Buka said.

strengthening the foundations

The World Bank has committed almost K6 million to achieve what it describes as strengthening the foundations for a conflict-free mining sector in the Autonomous region.

The ABG's recently established Department of Mining has a small number of staff and limited equipment and facilities.

The World Bank has committed the funds at the request of the ABG to build the capacity to manage the re-establishment of exploration and mining activities on Bougainville.

At the same time it is generally believed that the review of the Bougainville Copper Agreement can take place with or without the drawdown of powers because it is in effect a review of an act

of the PNG parliament, the reports indicated.

The principal target of the K6 million funding is ABG's future DoM staff, who will be supported to establish the organizational framework for the department and implement an effective policy and regulatory environment for mineral exploration and development in Bougainville, the World Bank said.

Transitional arrangements can facilitate granting of exploration and mining licenses for Bougainville as mining powers are transferred to ABG.

Also targeted are a Bougainville Sustainable Mining Policy, operation of a functioning ABG Department of Mining, a Bougainville Mining Act, a Bougainville Mining Safety Act and enabling regulations, hiring of professional staff for the ABG Mining Department, twinning of

ABG Mining Department staff into MRA and the PNG Mines Department, or other appropriate organizations, the Bank says.

As well as planning for large scale mining should a resumption be endorsed by the general population, the Bank also directs funding towards the development of small-scale mining support services and outreach on Bougainville. Mine related issues, particularly those at Panguna, are seen as central to the conflict that grew into the Bougainville Crisis, and a World Bank document pays respect to the risks as well as the potential benefits of promoting a return to both large-scale and small-scale artisanal mining.

"The possible re-establishment of mining activities in Bougainville will have critics and has the potential to re-ignite conflict in some areas

if not managed appropriately. "The Project will include development of a communications and information program to ensure that all stakeholders are informed of the Project objectives and activities, particularly in Bougainville," the World Bank document says.

"All extractive industry locations in Papua New Guinea are subject to occasional conflict, of en over benefits sharing.

"The focus on improving local governance and accountability is expected to help mitigate this risk.

"The Project will support training for local stakeholders in conflict resolution."

The World Bank, with more than K100 million to spend in several areas of support for mining throughout Papua New Guinea says it is including Bougainville in response to an invitation from the ABG to strengthen mining management capacity.

mining opportunities identified

The document points out that there are both benefits and risks involved in the re-introduction of mineral exploration and development in the Autonomous Region.

The opportunities relate to the benefits of mining which typically consist of direct and indirect large-scale and small-scale mining employment, mining-related financial transfers, and improved access to employment opportunities and services including in particular health and education services.

The risks include environmental disturbance, loss of land for subsistence agriculture, and possible cultural harm.

A gender bias exists whereby the bulk of the benefits accrue to men whereas the bulk of the risks fall upon women and children.

All of these benefit and risk issues need to be discussed and made known to all stakeholders, the World Bank says.

"With the Bougainville Peace Accord and the establishment of the Autonomous Government of Bougainville, Bougainville could again become a prime destination for mineral exploration," the Bank concludes.

What is an impact project?

Many commentators have used the expression "impact project" when describing the sort of economic boost required to provide jobs, training, infrastructure and business opportunity for Bougainville.

What does this expression mean?

An impact project is something very large, and the nearest example commentators can provide is the former operation at Panguna.

Everybody knows that from 1972 until 1989 when operations were suspended, Bougainville Copper Limited operated a large open pit mine and processing facility, producing copper concentrate containing significant quantities of gold and silver.

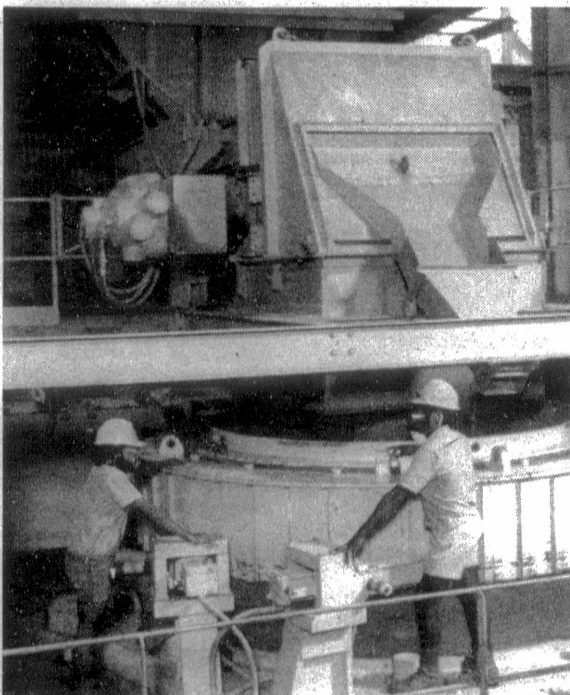
What some people perhaps do not know is the very large numbers associated with this first Bougainville "impact project".

In the 17 years prior to 1989, the mine produced concentrate containing 3 million tonnes of copper, 306 tonnes of gold and 784 tonnes of silver.

The production had a value of K5.2 billion.

Payments to the North Solomons Provincial Government and Panguna landowners, together with provisions made since 1990, amounted to K114 million.

Company training programs for some 12,000 employees, including approximately 1,000 completing full trade appren-



ticeships and some 400 completing graduate and post graduate studies, had previously resulted in considerable progress in the localisation of the company's workforce, and also added significantly to the number of skilled workers elsewhere in the country's mining and engineering industries.

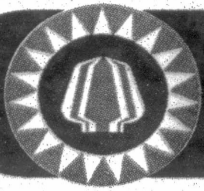
Further, the company's presence in the North Solomons Province had promoted the development of significant local business enterprises to provide goods and services required for the mining operation and for the residents of the province.

Contributions to the National Government in the form of taxes, duties and dividends were approximately 17 per cent of internally generated Papua New Guinea Government revenue during that time.

This represented 62 per cent of the net cash generated by the project between 1972 and 1989.

A recent study has reported that there is more copper and gold still in the ground at Panguna than has previously been mined, creating the possibility that another long period of employment, training, business opportunity and wealth creation could be supported.

It is very large numbers like these that describe an impact project, commentators said.

Bougainville reputation rising again



James Tanis visited Canberra to improve relations with Australia

The caretaker President of the Autonomous Bougainville Government, James Tanis, says there is ample evidence of the power of goodwill in mending broken relationships.

He says the restoration of relationships and the bridging of gaps between the ABG and the PNG National Government, between Bougainville and friendly foreign governments including Australia, New Zealand, Japan, the United States and others, as well as between non government organizations, churches and the wider community has paid off handsomely.

The Autonomous Region is reaping the benefits of this outreach, as the international community now has confidence in the leadership and the people of the ABR, because of the Government's handling of the previously sensitive situation, President Tanis said.

"People are now beginning to see and feel real tangible development taking place around them, after many years of false dawns.

"Work on the reseating and sealing of the Buka ring road is progressing well, with maintenance on the Kokopau-Arawa Highway an ongoing project.

ing project.

"The Japanese Government has also come to the aid of the people of Bougainville through the ABG by funding and building some fifteen bridges on the Highway and other Bougainville roads.

"Work on these bridges has already started.

"And to facilitate business development and social cohesion through communications, Telikom has been working on the installation of VSAT equipment on fourteen selected sites throughout the region, jointly funded by the New Zealand Government and the ABG," President Tanis said.

All this development and new-found confidence was a far cry from the situation prevailing at the time he took office, fourteen months ago.

Knowing that time was the greatest enemy, without the privilege of a full five years in office, President Tanis says he set out to restore broken relationships as the number one priority.

"Soon after my inauguration I went to meet the Prime Minister Grand Chief Sir Michael Somare on a one-to-one basis, to assure him that I would abide by the laws of Papua

New Guinea.

"I assured the Chief that I would not do anything behind his back, and asked for the same respect from him and the members of his Government.

"Reconciliation and peace building also took me to meetings with the Panguna landowners, the commanders of the various factions within the region, and the head of U-Vistract.

"Without delay, I also created the new Ministry of Peace, Reconciliation and Weapons Disposal, with the task and responsibility to oversee restoration and peace building in the region.

"The Peace Ministry is serving its purpose very well, facilitating a number of peace and reconciliation ceremonies."

President Tanis said the people of Bougainville were busy participating in the second Bougainville general election, and he appealed to all current members to continue to represent their people, and to deliver services to their constituents until the return of election writs in June.

"At this time it is only appropriate for me to wish all current Members and Ministers well in the election campaign," President Tanis said.

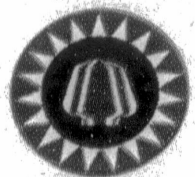

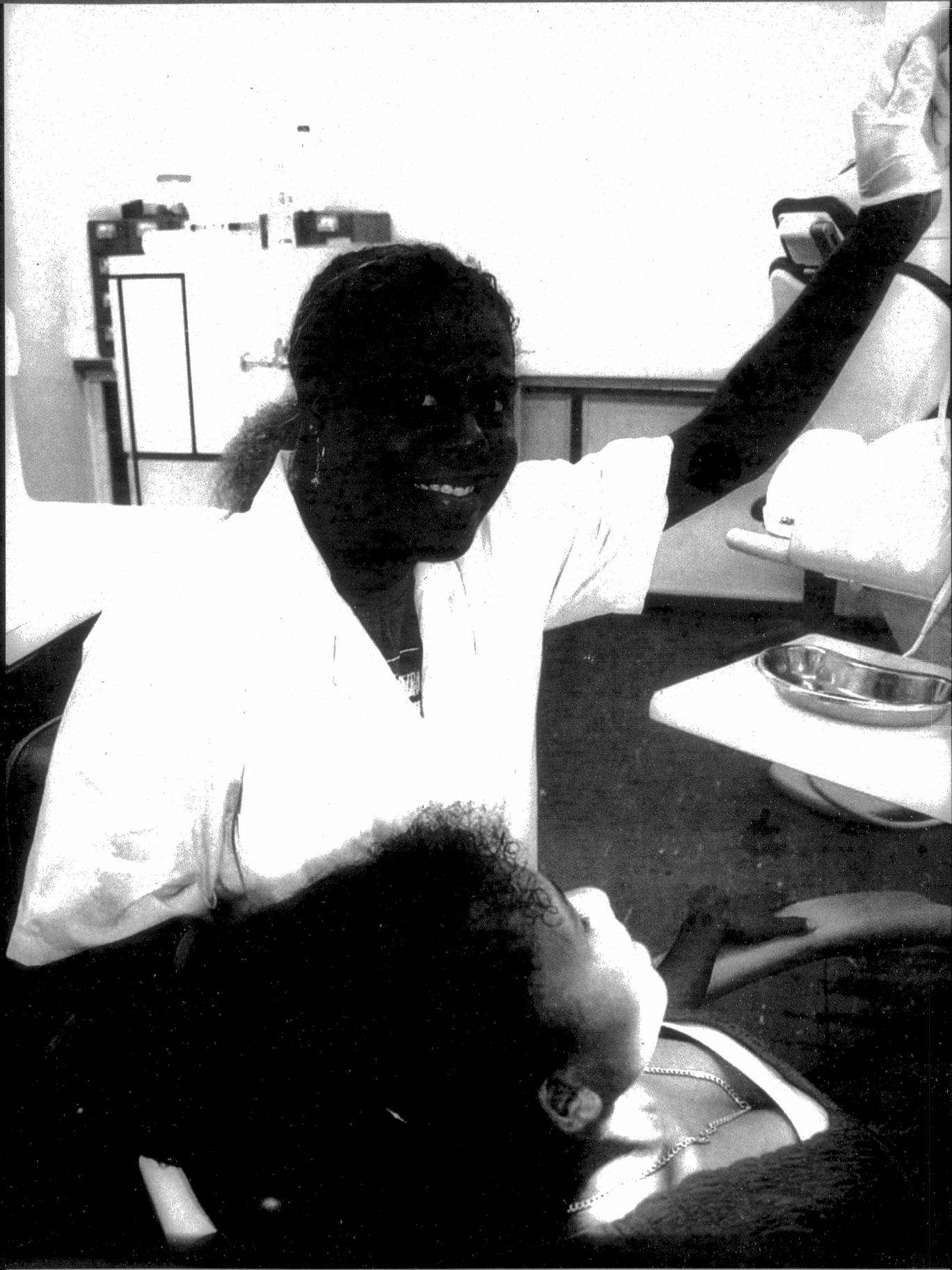
