

Sanford Lakoff to be visiting fellow at the European University Institute in Florence, Italy

Professor Sanford A. Lakoff, chairman of the Department of Political Science at the University of California, San Diego, will be a visiting fellow at the European University Institute in Florence, Italy, in May.

The institute recently was formed by several European nations in order to promote advanced studies in the social sciences and to facilitate communication between scholars.

Lakoff was invited to lecture by the institute, with support from the United States State Department. He will lecture on "Scientific Inquiry and Political Theory" and he will chair several seminar presentations.

At UC San Diego, Lakoff teaches the history of political thought and technology and society. He has written and edited books in both fields, including "Equality in Political Philosophy," "Science and the Nation" and "Knowledge and Power."
