

New book on computers being published this month by McGraw-Hill.

Clay L. Perry, director of the Computation Facility at the University of California, San Diego, is one of the authors of a new book on computers being published this month.

With George W. Evans, II, manager of the Mathematical Sciences Department at Stanford Research Institute, he has written "Programming and Coding for Automatic Digital Computers", which McGraw-Hill is publishing.

The book presents both the design and programming of computers and stresses the relationship between them. Assuming knowledge of college algebra, the authors discuss the construction of components, integration of the components into a computer, and derivation of number representations simulated by the computer. They use the flow diagram to describe programming procedures.
