HELLMANN NAMED ASSISTANT VICE CHANCELLOR AT UCSD

M. Boone Hellmann has been appointed to the position of Assistant Vice Chancellor, Facilities Design and Construction at the University of California, San Diego.

Hellmann joined UCSD in October, 1985, as an associate architect and has served as Acting Assistant Vice Chancellor, Facilities Design and Construction since January, 1988.

Hellmann received his architectural degree from the University of Idaho. Prior to coming to UCSD, he was a principal owner/partner of Hellmann & Mitchell Architects, Inc. of Reno, Nevada.

In his new position, Hellmann will direct the office responsible for construction of the major new facilities currently under construction or being planned for the fast-growing campus.

"We have a capital improvement program of \$481 million and an office of about 55 people," Hellmann said. "There are currently about 20 major capital improvement projects under design and/or construction, and probably another 100 minor capital projects also in the design or construction stage."

Hellmann is a resident of Encinitas.
