### An Asian American Art of Failure? Queering Masculinity After Bruce Lee

In the past several years, Asian American scholarly and popular discourses have 'reclaimed' the image and career of Bruce Lee, Chinese American martial arts superstar, to recuperate an Asian American masculine 'cool' from its subordinate status of orientalized, emasculated nerdiness. This talk traces the politicaleconomic and media coordinates of this nerd-cool binary, producing its most spectacularized instance of 'failed' masculinity in the 2004 American Idol appearance of UC Berkeley civil engineering major, William Hung. If poor William's brief career and longer legacy exemplify Asian Americans' racialized shame, the warrior-philosopher Bruce's Asian American revival promises the possibility of therapeutic, heteronormative pride. Yet what is at stake in this disavowal of shameful nerdiness? Not surprisingly, Asian American queer media artists have most productively and creatively taken to task the nerd-cool binary. This talk therefore closes with an analysis of two experimental queer videos: J.J. Chinois (2002), Lynn Chan's 2002 drag-king parody of Bruce Lee, and Maybe Never (But I'm counting the days) (1996), Nguyen Tan Hoang's playful deconstruction of queer nerdiness.


