

Jakob Zeitlin conducts seminar on works of Galileo

Jakob Zeitlin, an authority on the life of the 17th century physicist and astronomer Galileo Galilei, will conduct a library seminar on the works of Galileo at the University of California, San Diego, Thursday, January 6th, Melvin J. Voigt, UCSD Librarian, has announced.

The seminar, open to the public, is jointly sponsored by the UCSD Library and the Friends of the UCSD Library. The meeting will be held at 4:00 p.m. in the UCSD Humanities-Library Auditorium.

Mr. Zeitlin's bibliographical studies of Galileo are well known and have been the subject of lectures he has given throughout the country. He is a dealer and publisher with the Los Angeles firm of Zeitlin and Ver Brugge and has authored several articles on Galileo and other medieval bibliographical subjects. His subject for the UCSD seminar will be "The Bibliographical Misadventures of the Works of Galileo Galilei."
