NUTION OF APPROPRIATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the undersigned H. Taylor claims and appropriates all the water flowing or hereafter to flow in the channel of the Berhardo River, otherwise known as the San Dieguito River or Santa Ysabel River in the County of San Diego. State of California, at the point where this notice is posted, being in the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 18, Township 13 South, Range 2 West, San Bernardino Meridian, together with the water from all creeks or affluents of said river, to the extent of Ten Thousand inches measured under a four inch pressure of the continuous flow of said stream.

AGREEMENT.

Plates the construction and maintenance of a dam and reservoir in that part of Section Eighteen (18). Township Thirteen (13) South. Range Two (2) West. San Bernardino Meridian, known as Carroll Valley, in the County of San Diego, said State, and is desireus in connection therewith of acquiring the right to overflow, flood, inundate and store water upon certain lands lying along the course of the San Bernardo River (also variously known as the San Dieguito, Santa Ysabel and San Pasqual Rivor), and above the site of said dam; and the said first parties are willing to grant such rights to the said william G.
