

Dr. Carl Cepurneek awarded Fulbright fellowship

Dr. Carl Cepurneek, a postgraduate research biologist at UCSD, has been awarded a Fulbright fellowship for a year's study at the University of Adelaide, Australia.

Cepurneek will leave Feb. 11 for Adelaide, where he will conduct research in biochemical mechanisms and control of iron absorption.

In the UCSD biology department, Cepurneek has conducted research for the past two years on problems of iron metabolism. In collaboration with Dr. Paul Saltman, professor of biology and provost of Revelle College, he has been investigating models of regulatory systems in the human organism. At Adelaide, Cepurneek plans to test some of these systems in the university's department of medicine.
