

Special Memorial for Dr. Armin Rappaport

A memorial service for Dr. Armin Rappaport, professor emeritus of history at the University of California, San Diego, who died October 27, has been scheduled for November 17, from 3 until 4 p.m. in the Mandeville Recital Hall on the campus.

The service is sponsored by the Department of History and will feature remembrances of Rappaport, one of the most popular teachers at UCSD, by his colleagues, friends, and former students.

Rappaport, was a distinguished scholar of diplomatic history and from 1967 until 1969 served as the first provost of Third College.

Rappaport, 67, had officially retired from the UCSD faculty last July but was scheduled to teach an undergraduate history seminar for history majors this fall.

Rappaport maintained a home in Berkeley, California, but commuted to San Diego during the week to teach classes. He was a member of the history department faculty at UC Berkeley from 1949 until 1967 when he came to UCSD.

The memorial service is open to the public with a reception to follow.
