BACKGROUND: "Yucateca Sentada" ("Seated Woman of Yucatan") is the name of the sculpture by the well-known Mexican artist Francisco Zuniga. It is a bronze, life-sized statue of a seated peasant woman which will be installed on a terracotta-colored tile base outdoors on the Third College site.

The sculpture has been given to the UCSD campus by Elsa Dekking and Dr. Keith A. Brueckner, professor of physics at UCSD. It resided in their home prior to its donation to the campus.

Chancellor Richard C. Atkinson and Faustina Solis, Provost of Third College, are among the campus leaders invited to speak at this installation ceremony. Light refreshments will be served.
