PROGRAM TO HELP COMMUNITY COLLEGE STUDENTS TRANSFER TO UCSD SET FOR SOUTHWESTERN COLLEGE

Community college students interested in learning more about transferring to the University of California, San Diego under the Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) program are invited to attend an informational program at Southwestern College in Chula Vista, October 20.

The "TAG Day" program runs from 9 a.m. until 2 p.m. at the Southwestern Transfer Center and features presentations and workshops. Representatives from both UCSD and Southwestern will be on hand to answer questions.

The TAG program, which is in effect at nine community colleges in San Diego and Imperial County, is an effort to make it easier for students to attend a community college, then complete their final two years of undergraduate coursework at UCSD.

To be eligible, students must meet the following TAG guidelines:

- 1. Meet minimum eligibility for UC admission as a transfer student, including 56 UC transfer units.
- 2. Earn a minimum grade point average of 2.4 and be in good academic standing.
- 3. Clear all subject omissions/deficiencies in the areas of English and mathematics.
- 4. Complete all TAG core courses for general education with grades of "C" or better.
