Four renowned filmmakers will present their films in "The Black Filmmakers Series" to be held on four evenings during May at the University of California, San Diego.

Films by Raymond St. Jacques, Christopher St. John, Brock Peters and Max Julien will be shown. The filmmakers will discuss their films after each screening.

"The program is composed of current films that are not black exploitation films," according to Dr. Luther James, UC San Diego drama professor and director of the Black Cultural Sequence.
