Principal work on the program will be Mozart's last composition, the Requiem Mass. Soloists will be Maurita Phillips, soprano; Richard Levitt, counter tenor; Richard Robinson, tenor; and James Tippey, bass.

Roger Wagner, one of this country's great musicians, is the director of choral music at the Los Angeles campus of the University.

The concert is sponsored by the University's Committee for Intercampus Arts Exchange.
