

Katherine Anne Porter will offer lecturer-reading in La Jolla

One of America's most honored literary artists will give a free public lecture in La Jolla on Saturday night, March 4.

Katherine Anne Porter will offer a lecture-reading "A Defense of Circe" in Sumner Auditorium on the campus of the University of California, San Diego, at 8:00 p.m. Admission is free.

Mrs. Porter's fame rests on her mastery of the short story and short novel. Her books include "Pale Horse, Pale Rider", "Flowering Judas", and "Noon Wine". Some of her stories have already attained the stature of classics in American literature.

In addition to her skill as a writer, Mrs. Porter has won acclaim for her talent as a reader. She has recorded several of her stories.
