
Among tall, dignified palms, stately pines, and flowers in a riotous confusion


that causes the traveler to linger for more of the enchantment of the place. Far from the roar of the subway and the bustle of activity, dull care is tossed eagerly to the four winds.

Provision for your favorite sport has been made. You may wander over the spacious grounds of the Country Club or you may take more strenuous exer-








