NARRATIVE: I WAS SITTING IN THE CAR WITH MY COUSIN AND FRIEND AT THE ABOVE LOCATION WHEN 2 S.P.P.D OFFICERS PULLED UP AND BEGAN QUESTIONING US. THEY FOUND A GUN IN THE CAR THAT MY COUSIN RECENTLY PURCHASED.

WE WERE ARRESTED AND TAKEN TO COUNTY JAIL. I SPENT ONE DAY THERE, THEN I WAS TAKEN TO EL CAJON WHERE I SPENT 2 MORE DAYS. I WAS BROUGHT BACK TO COUNTY WHERE BORDER PATROL WAS CALLED AND I WAS DEPORTED.

MY COMPLAINT IS THAT I HAD A CHECK FOR \$1,400.- FROM DISABILITY DUE TO AN INJURY TO MY HAND AT WORK. I ALSO HAD APPROX. \$400.- IN CASH. NONE OF THIS MONEY WAS RETURNED TO ME. I WAS NOT EVEN GIVEN A RECEIPT FOR THIS MONEY. I ALSO DID NOT HAVE ANY CHARGES FILED AGAINST ME.
