

Cocktail reception to introduce Dr. and Mrs. Malcolm C. Moos to be hosted by Dr. and Mrs. William McElroy

University of California, San Diego Chancellor William D. McElroy and Mrs. McElroy will host a cocktail reception at 8:00 p.m. Sunday, September 8, at University House to introduce Dr. and Mrs. Malcolm C. Moos to community leaders.

Dr. Moos is the new chief executive officer of The Center for the Study of Democratic Institutions located in Santa Barbara. He and his wife, Tracy, will visit the San Diego area for several days.

Dr. Moos was named to his new position June 1 after serving as President of the University of Minnesota for eight years. He also serves as President of the Fund for the Republic, Inc., the parent organization for the Center, and, at the same time, as Chairman of the Center's Senior Fellows.

Dr. Moos and Dr. McElroy became friends when both were faculty members at Johns Hopkins University. Dr. Moos taught political science at Johns Hopkins for 20 years. He served as an administrative assistant to President Eisenhower from 1958 to 1960 and as a White House Special Assistant for one additional year.

He has also worked as an editor for the Baltimore Evening Sun, as Professor of Public Law and Government at Columbia University, as Director of Policy and Planning for the Ford Foundation, and as an advisor on public affairs to the five Rockefeller brothers during his career.

About 100 community leaders and staff and faculty members from UCSD are expected to attend the reception planned for the living room and the outdoor patios of University House.
