

Showcase for Young Composers presents grad works

The UCSD Department of Music's continuing Showcase for Young Composers will present a noon concert Thursday, January 14, in the Recital Hall, Building 409, on the Matthews Campus. The concert is free and open to the public.

The January Showcase will consist of works by graduate students Peter Salemi and Robert MacDougall. Salemi's "Disturbi Atmosfirici" is a trio for oboe, violin, and cello. "Symposium," by MacDougall, is a chamber piece for flute, clarinet, oboe, two guitars, violin, viola, and cello.

The conductor will be Larry Livingston.

To reach Building 409, take Gilman Drive north until it curves and ends at Myers Drive; turn left on Myers and then right on Lyman Avenue; the Hall is at the corner of Lyman and Russell Drive.
