STUDENT OUTREACH AND RECRUITMENT OFFICE CHANGES SCHEDULE FOR UCSD CAMPUS TOURS

Walking tours of the University of California, San Diego campus conducted by the Student Outreach and Recruitment Office (SOAR) now are available at 11 a.m. Monday through Saturday.

The previous twice-daily tours were cut to single tours, beginning Sept. 1, because of campus budget limitations.

-- The 90-minute tours are conducted by student guides and designed to give visitors a taste of the academic and social flavor of UCSD's undergraduate colleges.

Immediately following the tour, at 12:30 p.m. Monday-Friday, prospective students are invited to attend a general information session conducted by a SOAR Outreach Officer. The one-hour presentation reviews the differences among UCSD's five colleges, while also covering admission requirements and support services for students. Together, the tour and program provide a wealth of information for students who are making a college search.
