UCSD CONNECT will offer it's very popular course "Starting and Financing Technology Companies" this winter. Starting January 10, 2000, the course examines the components that affect the founding, survival and success of a new business venture.

Course instructor Ken Olson leads students through issues regarding the formation of new business ideas, raising capital, building a management team, finding corporate partners, understanding intellectual property issues, preparing market introductions, and creating value. Each class meeting gives students an opportunity to meet important leaders in the San Diego business community and to learn from their experiences.

"The sessions feature guest speakers who are San Diego's leading high-tech and biotech entrepreneurs and investors," says Olson. "Participants focus on learning how to think about starting and financing a high-tech company, including how investors evaluate technologies and analyze investment opportunities. This is a unique avenue for both networking and information gathering. Several successful companies were founded after the key players took this courses," Olson continues.

The course begins January 10, 2000 at 6pm in the evening and continues through March 13 on each consecutive Monday night. The location is the Sidney Kimmel Cancer Center at 10835 Altman Row, San Diego. The course fee is \$400 for individuals, with additional registrations from the same
