

U.S. Attorney General Janet Reno will discuss NAFTA and immigration issues at UCSD, Oct.7

EVENT: U.S. Attorney General Janet Reno will discuss NAFTA and immigration issues at the University of California, San Diego campus.

DATE/TIME: Thursday, Oct. 7 at 1 p.m.

LOCATION: The Robinson Auditorium at UCSD's Graduate School of International Relations and Pacific Studies (IR/PS).

FORMAT: Reno's talk will last approximately 25-30 minutes and will be followed by a 20 minute question and answer session for students and faculty only.

MEDIA ACCESS: Reno will be available for a period of approximately 15 minutes to respond to questions from members of the news media. This press availability will be held immediately following the Q&A session in the IR/PS Dean's Conference Room to the west of the auditorium. Reno's schedule will not permit any media interviews outside of this press session.

MEDIA ATTENDANCE: All members of the news media must register in advance to attend the talk and press availability. Only credentialed members of the news media who have registered will be admitted into the auditorium. The registration table for the news media will open at 12:15 p.m. Members of the media will be seated in a special section reserved for them.

TV/RADIO: Both audio and video feed lines will be available in the auditorium for use by the electronic media. The Attorney General's office has requested that TV camera persons remain stationary during the talk to ensure that there are no disruptions or distractions.

DIRECTIONS: To reach IR/PS, take the Genessee Avenue exit off of Interstate 5. Go west to Northview Dr., the north entrance to the campus. Go left on to the UCSD campus, then right at the first stop sign. Follow this street (Scholar's Dr.) south and turn left at the third street on your left (there will be an Institute of the Americas sign and a major construction project on your left). Turn right into the IR/PS parking lot at the top of the street. The Robinson Auditorium is on the east side of the IR/PS complex.
