

C-U Hospital tour is slated

A group of approximately 50 leading members of the community will have a special tour of the University of California, San Diego campus and the County-University Hospital beginning at 2:00 p.m., Sunday, October 8, under the personal direction of UCSD Chancellor John S. Galbraith.

Mrs. Thomas M. Hamilton of La Jolla arranged the tour so that interested persons in the community could view the operation of the hospital and the growth and future prospects of the San Diego campus and its Medical School.

Assisting the Chancellor on the tour will be Dr. Clifford Grobstein, Dean of the UCSD School of Medicine, and Dr. Frank West, a member of the University Associates, a community group formed to advise in the development of the campus. They will discuss in particular the implications of the operation of the downtown hospital by the University.

Following the tour, the Hamiltons will be hosts for a cocktail buffet in their Mecca Drive home.

Dr. Richard Lockwood, Director of Hospitals and Clinics for the University of California and Mr. John R. Moore, administrator for the County-University Hospital, will assist with the tour around the hospital.
