

Lee Marvin to present fishing trophies

Hollywood actor and Oscar winner Lee Marvin will award the trophies Friday evening (August 11) to the top teams in the Third Annual Intercollegiate Pacific Coast Deep Sea Fishing Tournament now taking place in San Diego.

Marvin, whose most recent movie is "Point Blank" will hand out the trophies at the official weigh-in beginning at 4:00 p.m. Friday, at the Marlin Club on Shelter Island. Six teams, representing five campuses of the University of California and the University of Southern California, are taking part in the tournament. Competition began Thursday morning and will end Friday evening with a dinner at the Marlin Club.

Each collegiate team consists of three anglers and a coach. They are being housed on the University of California, San Diego campus during the tournament. UCSD is serving as host for the annual event.

Scoring for the tournament is simple: one point will be awarded to a team for each pound of fish caught. School and individual team member trophies will be awarded to the tournament champions and runner-up teams. Individual trophies will be awarded to the angler catching the heaviest fish and to the angler with the most individual points.
