

## Friedrich Durrenmatt's "Play Strindberg," will be presented June 6-8

Three performances of Friedrich Durrematt's "Play Strindberg" will be presented June 6 through 8 by graduate students in the Department of Drama at the University of California, San Diego.

Curtain will be at 8 p.m. for regular performances June 6 and 7 and at 7:30 p.m. June 8 for a special performance for members and guests of tile Alumni & Friends, UC San Diego. The play will be given in the UCSD Studio Theatre in Building 409 on the Matthews campus.

The comedy, an adaptation of August Strindberg's "The Dance of the Death," concerns the eternal triangle and the setting of the story is a boxing ring.

Directing the production is Frank Condon, a candidate for the Master of Fine Arts degree at UCSD.

The special Alumni & Friends performance will be followed by an informal discussion about the play with the director and cast and a wine and cheese party.
