Dear Sir:-

If the deed from the Company to Mr. Fletcher and Mr. Gross contains the following:

"This conveyance is authorized by special resolution of the Board of Directors adopted at a regular meeting of said Board held February 27, 1909 at 9:30 o'clock A. M. at the office of the Company in San Diego, California, at which all Directors were present to-wit: William B. Gross, Ed. Fletcher, John H. Kleine, Ferdinand Thum and Thos. Ballantyne, and all voting in favor of said resolution except. Directors Ed. Fletcher and William B. Gross not voting."

The title companies would pass the title but if such authority does not appear in the deed the companies would require a certified copy of the resolution to be recorded with the County Recorder before passing the title.

The reason for this is that the officers of a company can not deed property to themselves without being authorized by the Board of Directors and this authority must appear on record either in the deed or by certified copy of the Resolution.

I suggest that a new deed be executed in lieu of the one submitted to me, containing the above, or similar form showing the authority to execute such deed.

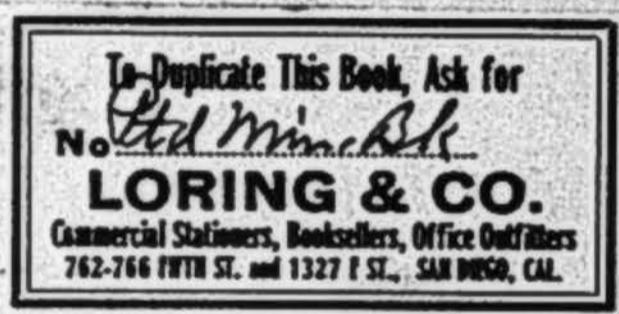

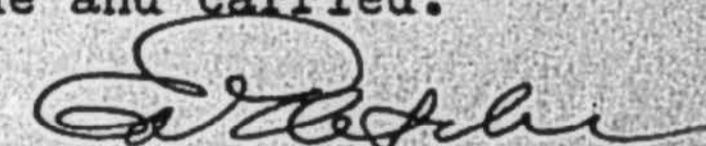

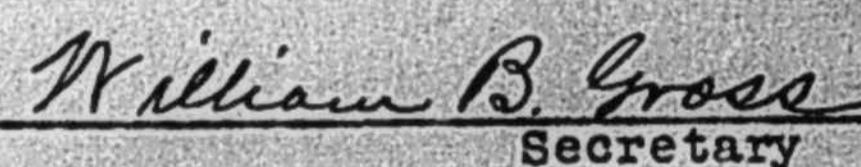
