HISTORY PROFESSOR WINS PRESTIGIOUS AWARD FOR ARTICLE

Steven Hahn, professor of history at the University of California, San Diego, has been selected by the Organization of American Historians as winner of the 1991 "ABC-CLIO America: History and Life Award."

Hahn was cited for his article, "Class and State in Post-emancipation Societies: Southern Planters in Comparative Perspective" which appeared in the February, 1990 issue of the "American Historical Review." The award will, be presented at the annual meeting of the OAH in Louisville, Ky., April 12.

The "ABC-CLIO America: History and Life Award" is given to recognize and encourage scholarship in American history in the journal literature which advances new perspectives on accepted interpretations or previously unconsidered topics.
