

C. Hubbs named member of Pacific Science Board of the National Academy of Sciences

Dr. Carl L. Hubbs, Professor of Biology at the University of California's Scripps Institution of Oceanography, has been named a member of the influential Pacific Science Board of the National Academy of Sciences.

The Board aids scientists of the United States who wish to engage in scientific investigation in the Pacific area, advises governmental and other agencies on scientific matters pertaining to the Pacific, and furthers international scientific cooperation in the Pacific area.

There are 11 members of the Board. Each serves five years.
