The appointment of R. Lawrance Bailey as director of development, Marine Sciences, at UCSD's Scripps Institution of Oceanography is announced by Rick Podgorski, assistant vice chancellor, Development, at UCSD.

Bailey served the past three years as associate director of development, Health Sciences, at UCSD. His appointment to the new position followed a nationwide search.

In discussing his appointment Bailey noted, "Discoveries at Scripps Institution of Oceanography have shaped our understanding of the global environment in the 20th century. Now, more than ever, we need to know how and why the environment is changing. My role is to help build an endowment that will be the foundation for the next century of discovery at Scripps."

Prior to joining UCSD he held various development posts in health sciences at UC Irvine and was program representative for film and television at UCLA Extension. His past experience also includes writing for an ABC-TV game show; teaching adult education classes in natural history, backpacking, and cross country skiing, and founding The Nature Center, a non-profit environmental education center in Los Angeles. A former chair of the West Los Angeles Sierra Club, he was active for a number of years leading trips throughout Southern California.

Bailey graduated from the University of Kansas with a degree in film/television and human relations.
