

Steve Relyea appointed vice chancellor for business affairs

NEW VICE CHANCELLOR APPOINTED AT UCSD

The appointment of Steve Relyea as vice chancellor for business affairs at the University of California, San Diego was approved today by The Regents of the University of California.

Relyea's appointment becomes effective on April 1. As vice chancellor, Relyea will be responsible for UCSD's physical plant, business services, food services, police department, student housing, financial services, and staff personnel and affirmative action.

Relyea is currently acting vice chancellor for administrative and business services at the University of California, Irvine. His responsibilities at Irvine closely parallel those he will assume at UCSD. He has also worked for the California Department of Health and served as associate dean for planning and administration at the California College of Medicine.

Chancellor Richard C. Atkinson expressed great pleasure at the recruitment, which culminated a national search. "Mr. Relyea's years of experience at the university level in the area of business and finance, as well as his involvement in various campus and university-wide committees have prepared him well for assuming the position of vice chancellor for business affairs at San Diego."

Relyea said of his appointment, "I am very excited about the opportunity to join the UCSD campus and look forward to being a part of an institution that is internationally known for its excellence in research and teaching."

A graduate of the School of Social Sciences and the Graduate School of Management at UC Irvine, Relyea also completed the Harvard University Program in Multi-Institutional Collaboration and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology Program in Systems Dynamics.

The former vice chancellor for business affairs, H. D. Johnson, retired in September of 1985. In the interim, Vice Chancellor for Administration V. Wayne Kennedy assumed acting responsibility for the business affairs area.
