

## UC Philosophy professors hosted by UCSD

**January 26, 1966**

The San Diego campus of the University of California will play host Saturday and Sunday, January 29 and 30, to a conference of Professors of Philosophy from all of the University's campuses. Between 50 and 60 persons are expected to attend to discuss ways of promoting intercampus exchange of students and staff.

The entire University of California now has the largest philosophy staff of any institution in America. It includes some of the most distinguished persons in the field as well as some of the most promising younger men. It is hoped that the San Diego conference will pave the way for greater utilization of the University's resources in philosophy for teaching and research.

The conference will consist of several panel discussions dealing with the general development of philosophy on the various campuses, and with specific projects that could be carried on with the resources of two or more campuses.

A noon luncheon will be held Sunday in the Central Facilities Building at Revelle College honoring Dr. Jacob Loewenberg, Professor Emeritus of Philosophy at Berkeley, for his 50 years of service to the University of California. Professor Loewenberg will address the group after the luncheon.

A reception will be held Friday evening for the conference participants at the home of Professor and Mrs. Avrum Stroll in La Jolla. Another reception is planned for Saturday evening at the La Jolla home of Professor and Mrs. Richard Popkin. Professor Popkin is Chairman of the Department of Philosophy on the San Diego campus.
