Dear Sir:-

On May 10th you sent me a letter from O. A. Edwards of 4718 - 36th St., Normal Heights, complaining against a bill of \$1.90 for water for the month of April.

I had just written you regarding this matter when Miss Fletcher phoned stating that Mrs. Edwards was down stairs. I saw Mrs. Edwards and she paid her bill of \$1.90 after I had stated that should there be next month a bill larger than normal, that the Company would replace the present meter with a new one, would test the present meter and should it show readings too large, that the bill for April and also for May would be adjusted.

There has been considerable complaint over this bill and I thought it much better to agree to have the meter tested next month without charge than to insist that Edwards make a deposit of \$1.00.

I will attach a copy of this letter to the correspondence and hand it to Mr. Mathews for his file.

In going down to your office to pay my water bill I find that you have me charged with 1000ft of water or \$1.90 which I think is unjust Your man says the Meter is read correct which I do not dispute But nevertheless it is impossible for me to use 1000 feet of water in the month of April as you know it has rained most all of the time we have used very little water this month
