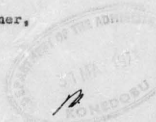

YANGKOK PATROL REPORT NO.1 of 1972/73  
AU WEST CENSUS DIVISION

Thank you for this report on which I comment as follows:

1. The patrol encompassed 22 census units ( 3 with populations less than 100) and 4,698 people in 11 days. Whereas some of the units may be in close proximity and in some cases may not have rest houses an endeavour should be made, when possible, for the patrol to overnight in each census unit, and as far as is practicable rest houses should be established to this end.
2. Did the Council Clerk accompany the patrol to represent the Council in Court actions against tax defaulters?

4. I note this is the first patrol report from Yangkok for the year.
