Whereas some of less than 1000 and 7500 proximity and in some case may not the units may be in close proximity and in some case may not have rest houses an endeavour should be made, when possible, for the patrol to overnight in each census unit, and as far as is practicable rest houses should be established to this end. Did the Council Clerk accompany the patrol to represent the Council in Court actions against tax defaulters? 2. 3. Copies of my comments concerning situation reports are attached.
