PRESS ADVISORY: FINAL STATISTICS ON UCSD'S FALL '98 ENROLLMENT

The University of California, San Diego posted a record enrollment of 19,370 students in the Fall 1998 quarter. The total encompasses graduate students, medical students, and undergraduate students, including a freshman class of 3,373 with a mean high school grade point average of 3.89 (down from 3.9 in Fall 1997) and a mean SAT score of 1,241 (up from 1,233 in Fall 1997).

The charts below track the growth of the UCSD student population (Chart A) and provide a breakdown of the new freshman class by gender, ethnicity, and discipline (Charts B, C and D).
