196.50 Set a post marked A.H.No.3 in mound of stone for cor. No.3, this being the spot pointed out to me as one of the original cors. of this Rancho.

136.00 Cross trail course N. & S.

150.00 Top of hill and set a post in mound of earth marked A.H.No.4, for NE. cor. of this survey.
