The engravings will be in size 3½x6¼, and will cost eight (\$8.00) dollars each.



Dear Sir: - I send you inclosed, an appeal for the irrigation districts of California. I send you this by direction of the state convention of irrigation districts. It explains the work being done this winter before the legislature of California to secure desirable amendments to the irrigation law, with a view to placing the bonds in such a position that they can be sold at par. After consultation with a number of bankers and capitalists interested in these bonds, we have come to the conclusion that if these amendments can be adopted there can be a ready sale of our bonds at par, or very nearly so, and some think at a premium. We need money for this work, Men have to be kept at Sacramento, to do this work and their expenses must be paid.

We ask that each irrigation district in the state contribute the sum of \$50.00 towards this work. That if they have any bonds out, the bondholders should be interviewed and letters should be written by all bondholders to their representatives in the legislature, asking them to support these measures. Will you please inform me by letter what your district can do financially and otherwise. Money should be sent to Hon. C. C. Wright, Capital Hotel, Sacramento.

I should be informed of the amount sent, let me hear from you on this subject.


