UCSD SOCIOLOGY PROFESSOR RECEIVES FULBRIGHT SCHOLAR GRANT

UCSD Sociology Professor Aaron V. Cicourel has been awarded a Fulbright Scholar Grant for the 1991-92 academic year. The grant will support his lectureship at Autonomous University of Barcelona, Spain in the coming academic year.

Individuals are selected for the Fulbright Scholar Program on the basis of academic and professional qualifications, in addition to their ability and willingness to share ideas and experiences with people of diverse cultures. According to the Council for International Exchange of Scholars, the program is designed "to increase mutual understanding between the people of the United States and the people of other countries."

The Fulbright Program is funded and administered by the U.S. Information Agency. Funding is also provided by participating governments and institutions in the U.S. and many other countries.
