UCSD HOSTS THIRD ANNUAL "ARTS AT UCSD" FRIEND-RAISER EVENT ON APRIL 17

"The Arts at UCSD," an annual event sponsored by the University of California, San Diego Board of Overseers, will take place on April 17 at the Mandell Weiss Center for the Performing Arts. The event is a special outreach program to introduce members of the community to arts activities at UCSD.

This year's artistic presentation will feature members of the 1990 graduating class of the Department of Theatre's Professional Theatre Training Program presenting material which they have prepared for upcoming auditions in New York City.

The evening's program, "Divertissements Dramatiques," will begin at 6 p.m. with a reception in the theatre's costume shop, where guests will have the opportunity to view costumes used in various UCSD Department of Theatre productions. At 7 p.m., a chicken with veal dinner will be served, both indoors in the theatre lobby and in an enclosure beneath the theatre's porte cochere, on tables set with bright pink cloths and decorated with multi-colored Gerber daisies.

After dinner, Stanley Chodorow, dean of the Division of Arts and Humanities, will give a brief overview of the academic and performance aspects of the theatre department. He will be followed by Arthur Wagner, professor of theatre, who will introduce the graduating actors and describe their presentations.

Each will receive the graduate degree of Master in Fine Arts in Theatre from UCSD's Department of Theatre's Professional Theatre Training Program.
