 - Vertical lines indicate unisons
 - Dynamic markings at bottom apply to entire ensemble except where otherwise marked.

T's are in unison within each group, but not between the two groups.
 "Ng" as in "wing"

The high pitch group is divided approximately in half, with half singing "Ü" and half singing "U".
 "Ü" indicates a French or German sound - pronounce "E" with lips in "ö" position.
 staccato!

"Wow" is in unison. Each pitch group stresses a different component of "Wow".
 Lo: "W"; Mid: "ö"; Hi: "Ü".

These sounds are made at random by individual members of the chorus, dynamics ad lib. All sounds staccato. Number of articulations indicated is not necessarily the number to be performed.

2 or 3 members repeat the section from the beginning of the piece.
 "Kq" is a tongue-click

These and other self-generating word groups are spoken by individual members.

Pitch changes here follow indicated intervals and arrows.
 Until end of breaths.

Quickly, with the speaker's first number beginning with the last "op".
