

Media advisory on inaugural conference on inorganic and nutritional aspects of cancer

WHERE: The La Jolla Village Inn, La Jolla, California

WHEN: January 2-5, 1977

THE CONFERENCE: The conference, which will bring together scientists from the United States and abroad, is sponsored by the International Association of Bioinorganic Scientists (IABS), the National Cancer Institute, and the National Institutes of Health. Dr. Gerhard N. Schrauzer, professor of chemistry at UC San Diego and president of the IABS, is conference coordinator. This is the first time a conference to discuss the role of nutrition in cancer cause and prevention has been held, according to Dr. Schrauzer.
