

Appointments of Dr. R. N. Hamburger and Dr. S. J. Singer

The appointment of Dr. Robert N. Hamburger as Assistant Dean of the School of Medicine, and Dr. S. J. Singer as Chairman of the Department of Biology at the University of California, San Diego, was announced today by Chancellor Herbert York.

Dr. Hamburger, an Associate Professor in the School of Medicine, will work with Dr. Joseph Stokes III, Dean of the School of Medicine, in planning and development of the new institution. Present plans call for the school to open in the Fall of 1967 with a first-year class of 32 students.

Dr. Hamburger received his M.D. in 1951 from Yale University. He was named a Diplomat of the American Board of Pediatrics in 1959. He came to UCSD in 1960 on a special fellowship and was named Visiting Associate Professor in Biology and the School of Medicine in 1963.

Dr. Singer was appointed Professor of Biology at UCSD in 1961. He received his Ph.D. in 1947 from the Brooklyn Polytechnic Institute and before coming to UCSD, served as Professor of Chemistry at Yale University.

Dr. Singer will replace Dr. David M. Bonner who died May 2. Dr. Bonner was Professor of Biology and Chairman of the Department of Biology and had been at UCSD since 1960.
