Reference your undated minute.

I acknowledge with thanks receipt of Situation Reports 1 to 4 arising out of the above patrol of the MOROBE SOUTH COAST and LOWER WARIA Census Division, together with the appropriate assessments, as submitted by Mr. S.S.CUTLACK, Assistant District Officer.

Opposition to payment of Council Tax because of the belief that there has been no tangible achievements implemented by the Council is not an uncommon phenomenon. What is surprising is the fact that an active supporter and an instigator of the movement is the current Council President which indicates disenchantment within the Executive with the Council and its ability to effect worthwhile and acceptable achievements. Situation Report No. 1 refers.

It is paradoxical that people representing a ~~area~~ from a neighbouring Council should wish to be incorporated into a Council which is beset with problems associated with opposition to payment of tax and inability to introduce worthwhile benefits for its taxpayers. Situation Report No. 2 refers.

Both these Situation Reports have been referred to the Commissioner for Local Government for his information and comment, if necessary. Your comments in respect of Situation Report No. 3 have been noted. I agree that political education provided it is thorough and unbiased should assist in combating wild rumours and exaggerated reports.

Situation Report No. 2 indicates a dismal and far from satisfactory state of affairs. Every effort should be made to rejuvenate the Society because of its former importance in the economic life of the people. I presume the necessary investigations are being carried out in respect of the allegations made in paragraphs 5(a) and 5(b) of the report.
