CUTTING THE EDGE CONCERT TO BE PRESENTED OCT. 22 AT UCSD

The San Diego Dance Theater and the Patricia Rincon Dance Collective, in collaboration with faculty members from the Department of Music at the University of California, San Diego, will present a concert, Cutting the Edge, at 8 p.m. Oct. 22 in UCSD's Mandeville Auditorium.

Jean Isaacs, artistic director of San Diego Dance Theater, in conjunction with UCSD composer and master sitar player Kartik Seshadri, will premier a piece featuring tabla player Arup Chatterjie. Isaacs' Dance Theater also will premier Mexican choreographer Adriana Castanos' Las Sirenas Tambien Esperan (The Sirens Are Also Waiting) to music by Franz Schubert. Las Sirenas is taken from Castanos' Thirst for the Sea, an ode to Odysseus.

Patricia Rincon, director of Patricia Rincon Dance Collective, and UCSD percussionist Steven Schick will present a cutting-the-edge premier utilizing creative rhythms and interwoven textures.

Tickets for the concert are \$18, general admission; \$15, faculty, staff and senior citizens, and \$13, students. The concert is part of State-Wide Conference 1999, Oct. 2224, hosted by UCSD's Department of Theatre and Dance for all dancers and dance educators, K-12, university and professional.
