THE ENDELLION STRING QUARTET WILL APPEAR AT UCSD ON MARCH 7

The Endellion String Quartet will perform a program of Haydn, Bartok and Beethoven at 8 p.m. Saturday, March 7, in the Mandeville Auditorium at the University of California, San Diego.

Tickets are \$18 for general admission and may be purchased at the UCSD Price Center Box Office or from TicketMaster outlets.

The program will be: Haydn: Quartet in B-flat Major, Opus 71, No. 1; Bartok" Quartet No. 6 and Beethoven: Quartet in E-flat Major, Opus 74 "Harp."

The members are: Andrew Watkinson, first violin; Ralph DeSouza, second violin; Garfield Jackson, viola and David Waterman, cello.

The quartet is an international performing group, frequently touring the United States, the Far East and South America, and regularly visiting such major European music centers as Amsterdam, Paris, Berlin, Frankfurt, Cologne, Munich, Geneva, Salzburg and Rome.

In Britain, the group broadcasts regularly on BBC Radio, and has made several television programs for the BBC2 series "Music in Camera." Endellion visits major British series and festivals, including the ones at Bath, Aldeburgh, Cheltenham, Harrogate and the City of London. Last year, the quartet performed a Beethoven Cycle at the Wigmore Hall, and were featured artists in the City of London Mozart Festival.

The group's discography includes recordings of Bartok, Mozart, Dvorak, Smetana and Haydn's Opus 74, among others. In 1987, EMI Records released the first ever complete recordings of Benjamin Britten's string chamber music.
